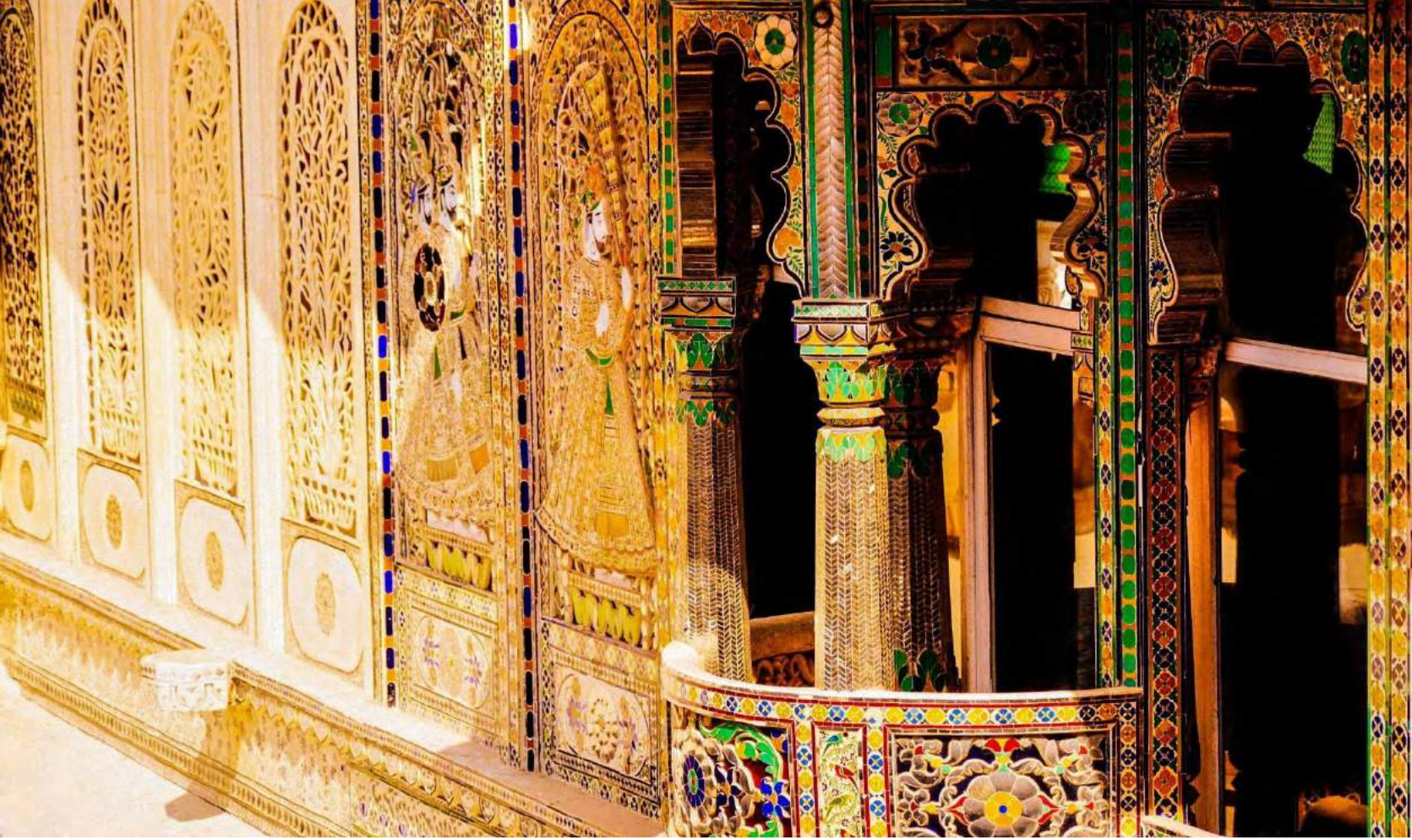

## **Day 1 – Jaipur / Udaipur**

Morning depart for Udaipur by surface from Jaipur. (395 Kms / 06 hours)

On arrival at Udaipur check-in at hotel.

Udaipur, the capital of the former princely state of Mewar is a beautiful city in Rajasthan, India. Udaipur city is also referred to as the "Venice of the East", the "Most Romantic City of India" and the "Kashmir of Rajasthan". Udaipur the "City of Lakes" is one among the most romantic and most beautiful cities of India. The city of Dawn, Udaipur is a lovely land around the azure water lakes, hemmed in by the lush hills of the Aravalli's. ## Day 2 – In Udaipur

We begin our tour of the historic city of Udaipur from the royal City Palace. City Palace towers over Lake Pichola. The main part of the palace is a museum displaying a large and diverse array of artefacts. There is also the armory museum exhibiting a huge collection of protective gear, weapons including the lethal two-pronged sword. Each quarter of the City Palace offers something different like the Manak Mahal which has a lovely collection of glass and mirror work, Krishna Vilas displays a rich collection of miniature paintings, the Moti Mahal has beautiful mirror work and the Chini Mahal has ornamental tiles all over. But the most noteworthy among these is the 129 year old Crystal Gallery at the Fateh Prakash Palace. The gallery showcases some of the most lustrous, rare and precious crystal from the royal treasure. These precious crystals were ordered from the famous manufacturers F and C Osler Company around 1877 A.D.





After that most famous temple of the Udaipur the Jagdish Temple. The temple was built in 1651 with Indo-Aryan style architecture. This three storey temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu, has the most beautifully carved pillars, decorated ceilings, painted walls and lush halls.

Evening enjoy a boat ride at Lake Pichola with the setting sun making the experience ever so magical.
