Criteria's for the member of good standing:

a. He/she should be the life member of the society.

b. Should have attended min 3 annual conferences as a life member in the past 5 years.

c. No financial default should be there on any form either in ISPPD or in any other society/ association.

- d. Should not have violated any rules of the professional registered body.
- e. No civil or criminal litigation pending.
- f. Should have actively participated in the association activities.
- g. Any member who assumes the post should execute the responsibilities.
- h. Any breach in the continuity will not be considered as a member of good standing

i. Any member who remains dormant from the association or the profession is not a good member.
