Overwhelming response to all Maharashtra Hotel Associations meet organised by AHAR

HAR convened the meeting of Associate members of all Maharashtra Hotel Associations on 9.2.2017 at 2.00 p.m. Swami Mukhtananda Sabhagriha, Bunatara Bhavana, Kurla. The Meet was organised to brief about the ban on Highway liquor vends by Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 15th December 2016, and its efforts, opinions, consultations, deliberations undertaken so far and the future course of action to safeguard the livelihood of thousands of affected Permit room holders, their employees and dependent ancillary industries throughout the state of Maharashtra.

The meet was attended by record number of 65 Hotel Associations throughout the State of Maharashtra.

The meet began with lighting of lamps by the President of AHAR and other presidents of prominent associations. Later on all the presidents and their teams were felicitated by the President of AHAR.

Addressing the gathering of around 500 hoteliers throughout the nook and corner of Maharashtra, President of AHAR Adarsh B. Shetty said that the ban on Highway liquor vends has come from the highest judiciary body of the country, Supreme Court. If it is implemented thousands of Hoteliers serving liquor up to 500 meter from Highway will lose their licenses, their livelihood and thousands of employees will also be rendered unemployed.

AHAR, HRA [WI] and other prominent associations came together and had 2-3 crucial meetings in the recent past. The opinions of prominent legal brains of State and Supreme Court were obtained. The opinions were forwarded to the leading counsels of the country for their guidance. So far an amount of around Rs. 20 lakhs has alreaady been spent as professional charges for obtaining these opinions. Since it was a decision of the Supreme Court, the gravity of the case is so deep and wide it was necessary to employ known face of legal luminaries to present and convince the Government about the perils which will cost heavily. He said we are also trying through various sources and process to denotify the highways as has been proposed / done is done in few other states. It is a battle of survival and we must come together and fight it.

All the participating associations agreed with his views and assured their full support in whatever possible way to AHAR and requested it to take the lead and go ahead. They also assured spreading the necessity of participation by other associations, who were unable to attend this meeting.

Many presidents of other associations appreciated the effort of AHAR in bringing them all under a single platform, taking a lead and the deep involvement in the matter. They expressed their gratitude to AHAR for its support and hope that they will get the desired relief.

President AHAR Adarsh B. Shetty answered and clarified various doubts, queries raised by the participants.

The President of AHAR appreciated the efforts of Vishwapal Shetty and Sunil Patil for the smooth coordination and the participation in wholesome in the meeting. The President also thanked all office bearers for making the event a grand success with active participation and their involvement.

The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks by Hon. Gen. Secretary Santosh R.

The house unanimously agreed for the same and approved Rs. 10, 00,000/- as our financial support to HRA [WI] in this regard.

Events of the month

Addressing the gathering, President Adarsh Shetty briefed as under:

• The ban on liquor sale on

highways by the Supreme Court order will have a devastating effect on the hotel industry as many of the hoteliers will lose their licences and their livelihood too. A number of employees will become unemployed. He said AHAR through various consultations, discussions is attending this grave situation. He said that we along with all Hotel associations of Maharashtra are attending the matter and will brief the future developments to all concerned. AHAR will not allow any stone unturned to reduce/remove the sufferings of the Hoteliers in Mumbai and Maharashtra in Highway ban matter. He also said that we have got many opinions by the legal experts which will be referred to our counsel who will decide the future course of action. He also said that the support and request for associating their Association in this fight has been received from more than 50 associations throughout the State of Maharashtra. These associations from all parts of Maharashtra are willing to fight under the umbrella of AHAR.

- MRP The members are advised to sell the packed commodities at MRP rate across the counter and any rate fixed by the Restaurateurs by the Hoteliers if served inside the Restaurant.
- He also advised the Restaurant who are charging service charges to customers to display the information prominently in the restaurnat premises and also mention it in every page of the menu card.
- Government of Maharashtra and MCGM has requested AHAR to support them to encourage the Voting by offering some incentive, discount, complimentary etc. and also to display posters, banners, standees for voter awareness. President advised the Hoteliers to offer any incentives of their choice

to the person who had voted in the coming elections.

- The Dance Bar case pending in Supreme Court, which has already directed State Government to renew 69 licenses submitted. The WP challenging the 29 conditions for renewal of Dance Bar licenses are coming for final hearing by 3rd week of February.
- Through our RTI enquiry, we have been informed by the authorities that the newspaper advertisement of service tax on takeaway is not a notification but to clarify the confusion regarding service tax and service charges.
- Reliance Energy has approached us with tariff reduction of Rs. 2/per unit if switched over from Tatas. We will study the same and revert.
- Our delegation also met the Tourism Minister, Govt. of Maharashtra, discussed and submitted the memorandum regarding the ban on highway liquor vendors. The meeting was very positive.

He thanked AHAR for making the online renewal of FSSAI a smooth affair. He appreciated the excellent work done by the present committee and wished the best for the newly nominated co-optees and special invitees and also for the new Sub Committee Chairmen and the coordinators.
