Care of the Burn-injured Patient in Resource-Restricted Environments

Overall Purpose of the Workshop:

The focus of this daylong workshop is to facilitate discussion among workshop participants using small group discussion and hands-on activities that speak to the care beyond the resuscitative phase of recovery. There will be five sessions primarily derived from the published ISBI practice guidelines for burn care ([https://www.burnsjournal.com/article/S0305-4179\(16\)30144-9/pdf](https://www.burnsjournal.com/article/S0305-4179(16)30144-9/pdf)). This pre-congress workshop provides an ideal opportunity to share experiences and learn from both the novice and expert. It is a great opportunity to learn from the best and from each other.

Topics to be offered for ISBI 2018, Delhi are:

- Pain and pruritus management
- Rehabilitation: mobility, positioning and splinting
- Non-surgical management of burn scar
- Metabolic management
- Respiratory care
