All Disability Compensation Systems share a common procedural approach to the determination of impairment and disability for purposes of providing benefit to injured persons whether from work injuries or road accidents, etc. The structural and anatomical consequences of the injury or disease are defined and measured according to medical impairment, which is used to estimate the individual's loss in terms of their capacity to perform activities of daily living (ADLs) and, presumptively, their losses in terms of vocational and non-vocational pursuits and quality of life. The Medical Doctor/Surgeon is most often asked to rate the severity of impairment in terms of a percentage loss to the "whole person" and according to criteria specific to each disability system. Often, the impairment percentage so derived, is then directly translated into a monetary sum for purposes of compensating these losses to injured persons.
