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Sub: Seminar for potential investors in Vietnam

Dear Members,

This is further to our circular no. 58 dated 15th June, 2015 inviting members interested in investing in spinning / weaving / knitting and processing sectors in Vietnam.

We would like to inform you that a team of officials from EXIM Bank will make a presentation on **'Investment opportunities for Indian Companies in Vietnam' at 2.30 pm on 23rd June, 2015 in the Conference Room at the Council's Head Office – 5th Floor Engineering Centre, 9 Mathew Road, Mumbai 400004.**

The presentation will include details of the Industrial Parks (IPs) / Economic Zones (EZs) in Vietnam which the EXIM Bank team visited in May. The presentation will help in making an assessment study of the identified parks with respect to investment opportunities, facilities on offer and infrastructural gaps. A Q & A session will follow the presentation.

Based on the investment opportunities available in these Industrial Parks, interested investors may consider joining the proposed delegation to Vietnam (dates will be intimated later) to get a first-hand knowledge of the existing facilities.

Vietnam is an important player in the region in view of its other entry routes through significant FTAs with EU, ASEAN-China and RCEP. With the TPP likely to become a reality in early 2016, it is important for India to link up with the textile value chain in the region.
