Dear Member,

Please refer to our earlier mails dated 10th March, 2015 and 13th March, 2015 requesting all industry associations and other stake holders to submit the demand for skill training job role wise, to be considered under Pradhan MantriKaushalVikasYojna (PMKVY). In response to the above mails, 154 textile mills submitted the data and got affiliated as Training Providers with Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC).

In the pilot phase of the scheme, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) has asked TSC to train 13,600 trainees and sanctioned a sum of Rs. 13.6 crores towards reimbursement of the training cost of these trainees.

Based on the criteria set by NSDC and the information received from the above mentioned mills, these number of trainees are apportioned to 109 mills out of 154 mills affiliated to TSC, for the pilot phase of the scheme starting from 25th May, 2015.
