Rice: About **6.93 lakh ha** area coverage under rice has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**5.69 lakh ha**). Thus **1.24 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Uttarakhand (1.23 lakh ha), Meghalaya (1.00 lakh ha), Nagaland (0.88 lakh ha), Assam (0.88 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.80 lakh ha), Arunachal Pradesh (0.70 lakh ha), Kerala (0.35 lakh ha), Mizoram (0.35 lakh ha), Maharashtra (0.33 lakh ha), West Bengal (0.20 lakh ha), Odisha (0.16 lakh ha), J&K (0.05 lakh ha) and Gujarat (0.01 lakh ha).

Pulses: About **2.52 lakh ha** area coverage under pulses has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**2.35 lakh ha**). Thus **0.17 lakh ha more area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Karnataka (1.49 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.33 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (0.28 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.28 lakh ha), Sikkim (0.06 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.03 lakh ha), Assam (0.02 lakh ha), Gujarat (0.02 lakh ha), Haryana (0.01 lakh ha) and Odisha (0.01 lakh ha).

Coarse cereals: About **8.07 lakh ha** area coverage under coarse cereals has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (**9.39 lakh ha**). Thus **1.32 lakh ha less area** has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area coverage has been reported mainly from the States of Karnataka (2.20 lakh ha), Uttarakhand (1.57 lakh ha), Jammu & Kashmir (0.95 lakh ha), Haryana (0.61 lakh ha), Rajasthan (0.40 lakh ha), Uttar Pradesh (0.38 lakh ha), Punjab (0.37 lakh ha), Tamil Nadu (0.20 lakh ha), Odisha (0.03 lakh ha), Andhra Pradesh (0.01 lakh ha) and West Bengal (0.01 lakh ha).
