State-wise Brief:

Andhra Pradesh : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 14.92 lakh ha compared to 14.83 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Chhattisgarh : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 3.24 lakh ha compared to 3.18 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Gujarat : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 21.65 lakh ha compared to 25.77 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Karnataka : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 8.84 lakh ha compared to 10.84 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Madhya Pradesh :

Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 63.84 lakh ha compared to 62.46 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Maharashtra : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 35.06 lakh ha compared to 34.10 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Rajasthan : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 18.84 lakh ha compared to 18.37 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Tamilnadu : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 2.30 lakh ha compared to 2.93 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Uttar Pradesh : Area covered under oilseeds up to this week end is 4.70 lakh ha compared to 4.28 lakh ha recorded during corresponding period of last year.

Crop-wise Brief:

Groundnut : Area coverage during Kharif 2012 is lower by 4.18 lakh ha compared to corresponding period of Kharif 2011, result of low coverage in the state like Gujarat & Karnataka due to less rainfall.

Soybean : Area coverage during Kharif 2012 is higher by 4.34 lakh ha compared to corresponding period of Kharif 2011. Higher coverage due more area in state like Maharashtra, Rajasthan compare to last year.

Sunflower : Area coverage during Kharif 2012 is higher by 0.03 lakh ha compared to corresponding period of Kharif 2011.

Sesamum : Area coverage during Kharif 2012 is lower by 2.00 lakh ha compared to corresponding period of Kharif 2011, less area is due to less coverage in states like Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka due to less rainfall.

Niger : Area coverage during Kharif 2012 is lower by 0.14 lakh ha compared to corresponding period of Kharif 2011.

Castor : Area coverage during Kharif 2012 is lower by 1.56 lakh ha compared to corresponding period of Kharif 2011.
