

INDIAN POULTRY INDUSTRY



Broiler (Meat)

- Average 65-70 Million/week Current
- 1/3rd of the production is done by Individual Farmers and remaining 2/3rd by Contract Farmers
- Average Farm Size is about 7000-8000 Birds
- Approx. 90000 Farmer Associated in chicken farming practices

Layer (Egg)

- An estimate of 220 Million birds in Production cycle- Current
- Egg Production ~70Billion 100% Individual Farmers
- Per Capita Egg Consumption 55/annum



POULTRY MEAT CONSUMPTION TO GROW AT A CONSTANT CAGR 7.5%








LAYER EGG TO SEE A STEADY GROWTH AT CAGR 5%







COMMODITY PRICE FLUCTUATION SOYA BEAN MEAL



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

COMMODITY PRICE FLUCTUATION MAIZE








PRICE FLUCTUATION ON LIVE BIRD SALE








DOMESTIC MAIZE & SOYMEAL PRODUCTION VOLUMES








HIGHER DOMESTIC REALIZATIONS CAUSES SHIFT FROM EXPORTS



Volatility in Broiler prices

Manage production efficiencies during lean seasons

- Cut down 20% of production
 - Per capita consumption during Q2 and Q3 come down due to festivals – Shrawan Period, Ramzan, Navratri & Ganesh Chathurthi


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
Volatility in Price of Maize and Soya.

Maize and Soya together constitute 90% of total feed ingredient

SUGGESTIONS

- Hybrid Maize and Soya production to be popularised
- Introducing Genetically Modified crops for higher yield and lower cost of production
- Estimate Crop Yield/Hectare is half the Global average




