Over 50 participants attended, including the Managing Committee Members and the Office Bearers of AIPMA, as well as our Banking Partner **CITIBANK**. The Seminar kicked off with President Er. R. K. Aggarwal's presentation on AIPMA and its activities.

UTKARSH as the next generation youth body was aptly presented giving the objectives and the benefits of the youth forum.

Utkarsh booklet was thus unveiled by Shri.Sanju Desai, Shri.Shailesh Sheth & Shri Arunaagiri Mudaaliar.

A Youth Council was thus formed with a Co- Chairman nominated by the Managing Committee, at UTKARSH 2016, pledging to work towards the professional development of the youth and building a roadmap for future and is expected to build momentum within the youth for the development of dedicated national action plans and strategies.

The vibrant and interactive session from Shri Arunaagiri Mudaaliar focused on the human behavior and the ways and means to explore the same in businesses.

3. The role of the new council and Co-Chairman
4. Roadmap for UTKARSH –The Youth Forum
5. Monitoring progress: Measurement and analysis to inform policies and build accountability

OPENING SPEECH

The official opening of UTKARSH –THE AIPMA YOUTH FORUM was held in at Modena Hall, Waterstones Hotel, Mumbai, was made by ever dynamic Shri Sanju Desai, Sr. Vice President and included speeches by Er. R. K Aggarwal, President, The All India Plastics Manufacturers' Association. Er. R. - ❖ Setting up Export Cell to provide information and assistance to all member with regard to plastics.
- ❖ Fighting against any national or international challenges confronting growth of Indian Plastic Industry.
- ❖ Promoting membership through zonal regions.
- ❖ Promoting Job and Career Fairs,
- ❖ Setting up Plastic Parks in various States
- ❖ Setting up Skill Development Centre and distance learning programme for Plastic Industry

Unveiling of UTKARSH booklet:

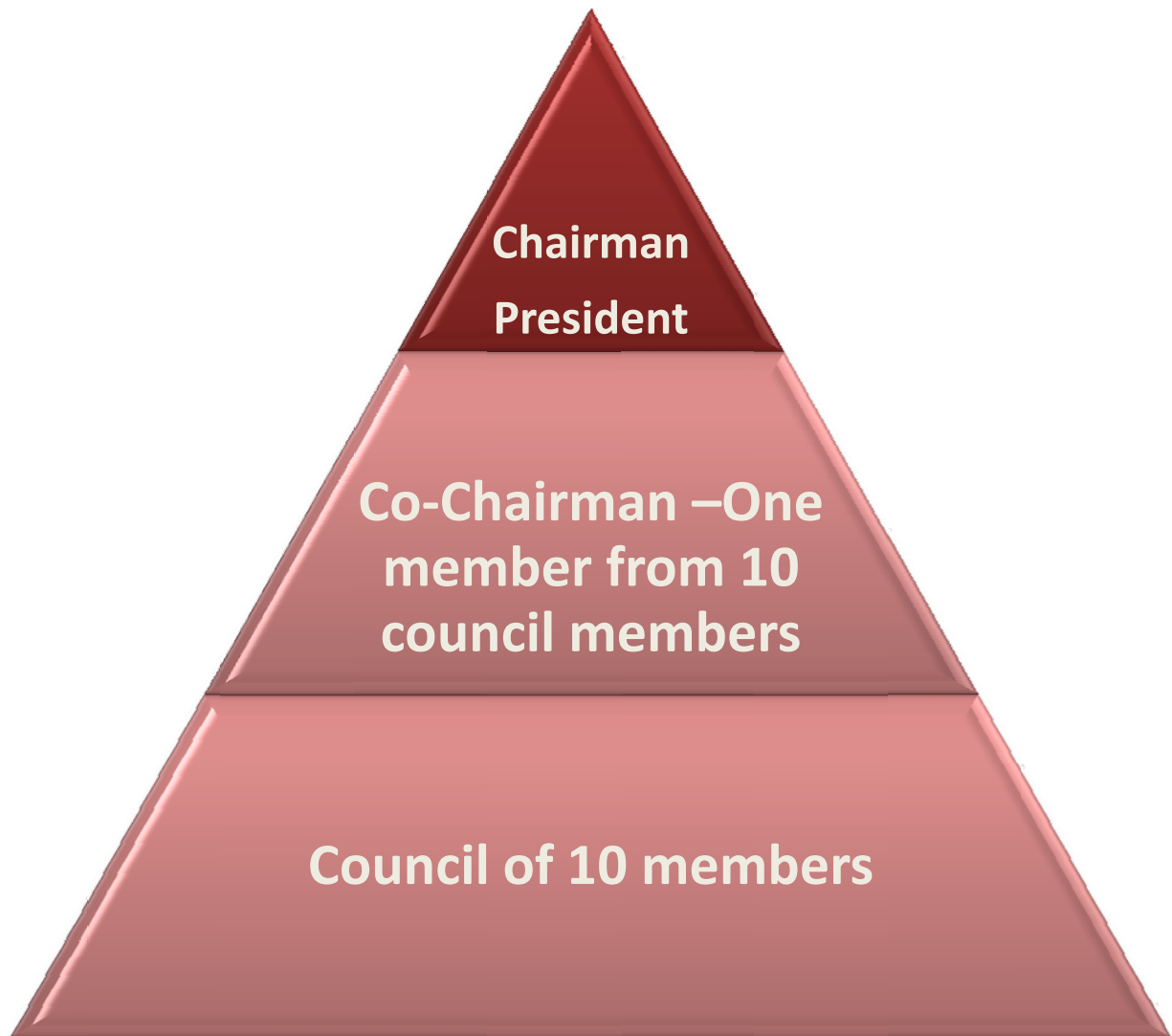
