Sabour is a beautiful countryside located in Bhagalpur district of Bihar and renowned for being one of the oldest colleges and research centres in the Indian subcontinent. Bihar Agriculture College (BAC), Sabour was established by the Britishers in the year 1908. It is located at 25°15'N latitude, 86°57'S longitude and altitude of 46 m above mean sea level. Bihar Agricultural University was established at the same place on 5th August, 2010 to serve as a leading centre of education, research, extension and training in the field of agriculture and allied subjects in the state. Within a short span of time, the university has received several accolades for its excellence in work.
