Do's & Dont's

All Exhibitors must Strictly Adhere to the following Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Fair Timing will be from 10.00 A.M to 9.00 P.M. on 30th & 31st January 2017.
- 2. NO DECORATION WILL BE PERMITTED INSIDE THE STALL OR OUTSIDE THE STALL OR IN THE PASAGE WAY. Only Flex, Standees, Mannequins, Posters of the Brand etc. can be used inside the Stall for Decoration.
- 3. ANY PERSON BELOW THE AGE OF 18 YEARS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE FAIR AREA.
- 4. NO MUSIC WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE STALL.
- 5. PHOTOGRAPHY IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED in the Entire Exhibition Area.
- 6. **SMOKING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED** in the Entire Exhibition Area including the Cafeteria & the Toilet.
- 7. Garments / Textile brought into the Exhibition Area will not be Permitted to be taken outside the Exhibition Hall till the end of the Exhibition.
- 8. All Stalls including Corner Stalls will have only **ONE SIDE OPEN.** The Maximum Height permissible for all the Stalls will be **8 Feet** to maintain uniformity.
- 9. Exhibitors cannot keep any Furniture, Display Material, Mannequins, Standee etc. outside the Stall or in the Passage Way.

- 10. Exhibitors are permitted to bring their own Racks, Stands and Mannequins for their use in their Stalls. Racks, Stands and Mannequins can also be hired from the Agencies who have been Empanelled by the Association.
- 11. No **INFLAMMABLE MATERIAL** will be permitted to be used by the Exhibitors in their Stall
- 12. Flood Lights and Halogens are Strictly not allowed in the Stalls as they are Fire Hazard and reduce the effectiveness of Air Conditioning thereby causing inconvenience to all.
- 13. The Decision of the Fair Sub Committee on the Exhibitors Booth / Stalls Erection and in all Aspects of the Organization of the Fair will be Final and Binding on all Exhibitors.
