Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. Submitting author are reminded that the Scientific Committee reserves the right to select or reject papers for presentation.
2. The Organising Committee will inform the authors of the status of their submissions by 15th March 2019. Alternatively, authors may also contact the Secretariat for verification via mcor2019.registration@latwin.com
3. Submission of a paper does not constitute registration for the congress unless it is accompanied by the completion of the registration with payment.
4. Selected abstracts will be available for download.

Instructions for Abstracts

1. Language: English
2. The whole abstract should not exceed 300 words
3. Format to submit: plain text

Poster Presentation:

1. Format of Abstract:
Title (Capitalised)
Name(s) of Author(s) with the presenter's name (registered abstract author)
The surname of each author precedes in the initials (e.g. Abdullah BJJ)
2. Institution(s) of co-author(s):
Authors from different institutions will be identified by matching superscripts e.g. Kumar G¹, Ong KT², Department of Radiology³ and Surgery⁴
3. Body of Abstract:
 - a. Purpose of Study
 - b. Materials and Method
 - c. Results
 - d. Conclusion
4. Authors of accepted abstracts are required to produce poster (Size: Portrait A1 [594mm x 841 mm]) or poster size not exceeding the penal space measuring 1 metre (W) x 2.5 metre (H)
5. All abstract must be received by the secretariat by 1st March 2019

Oral Presentation:

1. The total time allotted to each speaker is 10 minutes. Speaker should plan to speak for 8 minutes and leave 2 minutes for questions.
2. There is NO EXCUSE for using more than the allotted time. Rehearse the presentation several times; projecting slides and doing anything else you would otherwise expect to do during the presentation. It is a discourtesy to your audience, the Session Chair and the other speakers to exceed your allotted time. The Session Chairs are instructed to adhere to the printed schedule for the session. With parallel sessions this is critical to the overall success of the conference.
3. Recommend a presentation format of 4:3, 16:9 is also acceptable
4. The congress will be equipped with a computer video projector and a computer that is connected to the projector for each oral presentation room. Normal audio equipment such as microphones will be provided.
5. The computers are equipped with Windows 10 as well as Microsoft PowerPoint 2016 (Office), Internet Explorer/Edge (latest), Adobe Acrobat Reader DC/Flash Player, and Windows Media Player 12.
6. All the authors are requested to
 - a. visit the Speaker Ready Room at least one day prior to the session,
 - b. verify their presentation for compatibility and proper operation.

If necessary, especially if you have embedded multi-media content, you will have the final opportunity to adjust or tweak your presentation at that time. We suggest the presenting author to bring his/her own computer and a USB thumb drive with presentation materials as backup. You need to contact the MCOR Secretariat by 15th March 2019, if your presentation run under MAC's Keynote.

7. We advise the presenter to submit / upload the presentation data at the Speaker Ready Room no later than 18:00hr, on 6th April 2019, Saturday.
