
05 days / 04 Nights "Aurangabad & Mumbai"

Delhi 00 -Aurangabad 02 - Mumbai 02



Nestled in the Western India's state of Maharashtra is Aurangabad, the Tourism Hub of many Historical monuments including the famous UNESCO world heritage sites of **Ajanta & Ellora Caves**. The Rock-cut 29 Buddhist cave monuments at **Ajanta**, date from the 2nd century BCE to about 480 CE. The paintings and sculptures of Ajanta, considered masterpieces of Buddhist religious art, have had a considerable artistic influence. **Ellora** has over 100 caves as its site all excavated from the Basatt cliffs in the Chanrandari Hills consisting of Hindu Jain & Buddhist representing cities and mythologies serving as monasteries, temples for Pilgrims. Cave 16, in particular is world famous for the largest single monolithic excavation in the world, the great Kailasa. Next we visit Bollywood city of Mumbai.

Ajanta: are the first Buddhist cave monuments at Ajanta dating from the 2nd and 1st centuries B.C. The paintings and sculptures of Ajanta, considered masterpieces of Buddhist religious art, have had a considerable artistic influence.

Ellora: is also world famous for the largest single monolithic excavation in the world, the great Kailasa (Cave 16).

We continue sightseeing and visit the **Mani Bhawan** known as the political activity headquarters of father of nation Mahatma Gandhi. After the tour return to Hotel.
