MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT, MSGH & ORGANISING CHAIRMAN, GUT 2009

I would like to invite you to our mystical and magical island of Langkawi come August 2009 for our annual scientific meeting — GUT. GUT is more than just our annual scientific event. It is a gathering that gives us the opportunity to mingle, socialise and more importantly to expand the horizon of our knowledge.

As you know, GUT is the highlight of our MSGH activities. It gives us the chance to visit new topics and revisit significant previous ones. In addition to introducing new themes, it is the aim of MSGH to expand our minds to new possibilities, strengthen the knowledge of common themes and also to familiarize us to new changes.

For this year we are tailoring our scientific programme and concentrating on the topic of GI cancers particularly on colorectal cancer. It is especially important to recognise this entity after the release of the recent report on the National Cancer Registry showed that colorectal cancer is now the commonest cancer among males and third among females, beaten only by other GIs and neuroendocrine tumours. This suggests that there are a lot of interventions that we need to undertake to tackle this horrifying disease.

Naturally, in addition to cancer, we have drawn up this scientific programme with a generous helping of general topics that will be of interest for everyone, encompassing gastroenterologists, surgeons, general physicians, family medicine specialists, public health, allied medical health especially GIAs, medical officers in the general field of medicine and more so any medical officer who has interest in GI and hepatology. The inclusion of primary health care issues will be of interest to the attending GPs and family medicine specialists, and I urge them to participate and bring home valuable lessons.

As in previous years, we will have numerous plenary sessions, symposia, special lectures and also interesting case discussions both in gastoenterology as well as in hepatology to tackle small common topics that are of interest to all.

Since this is an important meeting with the participation of all the members in our field, I urge all the members especially the trainees and medical officers to present their work so that we may all learn and teach the finer points of medicine amongst us. Since the conference is three months away, I hope that the interim time will allow more abstracts to be completed and submitted in time.

Finally, a note of thanks to all the Organising Committee members, especially Prof Dato' K L Goh, Chairman of the Scientific Committee, all the distinguished speakers; local as well as overseas, secretariat and not forgetting the sponsors, without which this meeting would never have been successful.

GUIDELINES

- 1. Delegates are invited to submit papers for poster presentation. Five of the best submissions for the Young Investigator's Award shall be selected for Oral presentations.
- 2. Only abstracts received by **15**th **July 2009** and accompanied by appropriate registration fees will be considered.
- 3. Abstracts must be in English.
- 4. The length of each abstract should not be more than 400 words.
- 5. The title (in bold full capitals) should be concise yet bear sufficient details to identify the nature of the study.
- 6. The name of the main author should be underlined. Institution from which the work originated, city and country should be included. Omit degrees and institutional appointments.
- 7. The body of the abstracts should be organised in the following sequence: Objective(s), Methodology (if pertinent), Results (graphs are permitted), Discussion and Conclusion(s). Abstracts which do not include Results and Conclusion(s) will be rejected. Abbreviations, if used, must be included in full at some point in the text. Abbreviate measurements (mm, kcal) as recommended in the Style Manual of Biological Sciences and System International (S.I.) units should be used.
- 8. Drugs should be given in generic terms (in small letters) at first mention in the text, to be followed by the proprietary name (capitalised) if desired.
- 9. Abstracts can be submitted online at www.msgh.org.my. The closing date is 15th July 2009.
