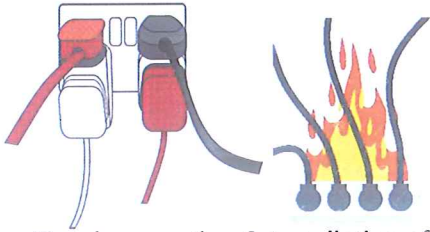

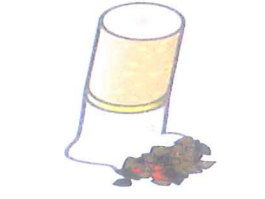
Illegal connection & Installation of electrical box behind the drywall

Improper disposal of cigarette

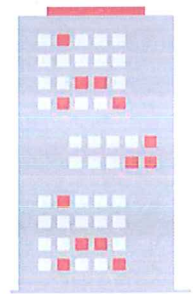
If a fire breaks out in your unit:

Leave the room where the fire is and close the door. Alert anyone in your unit and leave. When closing the unit close the door behind you. **Do not** stay to put out the fire. Use the staircase to exit the building. **Do not** use the lift.



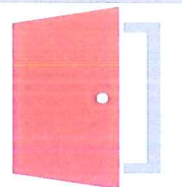
If you see or hear of a fire in another unit or part of the building:

It will normally be safest for you to remain in your unit. However, you are of course, free to leave the building if you would prefer to do so. If you are instructed to leave by a member of the emergency services, you should do so immediately. In either case, use the staircase to exit the building. **Do not** use the lift.



Fire Doors save lives:

Do Not leave a fire door wedged or propped open.



This building is designed to contain a fire within the condo or area where it starts.

Dial 999 and wait for the fire service to arrive. Do not re-enter the building

A high degree of fire separation between unit and the rest of the building is achieved by making each unit a fire-resisting enclosure. This is known as compartmentation.
