Man-made Fibre is the most versatile raw material in the world. 72% of the fibre used to manufacture T & C products is Man-made, and the remaining 28% is natural fibre. India is the second largest producer of Man-made Fibre and the sixth largest exporter of it in the world. Fashion labels, retail chains and manufacturers are increasingly using Man-made Fibre textile products to the extent that in a USD 333 billion textile market (excluding garments), USD 180 billion, i.e. 54% is being contributed by MMFT.

1,441 million kg of Man-made Fibre, 3,583 million kg of filament and spun yarn and 24,643 million sq. m. of fabrics, a self-sufficient raw material production base and a long and varied tradition of textiles is what India has to offer to the international buyer.
