like automotive, healthcare, infrastructure, oil and petroleum, among others.

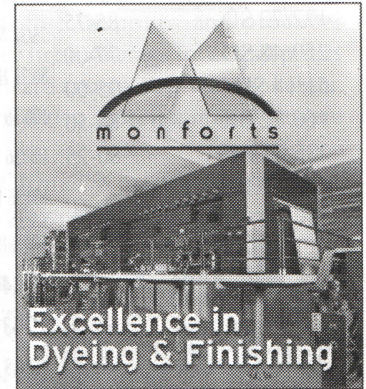
