- Considering huge untapped potential of Egypt's textile market, Council organized participations in Stand Alone Exhibitions/International Fairs for its members during 2007, 2010 and 2015 with rewarding outcomes
- ✓ Currently SRTEPC is given a 'Lead Council' by MOC to organize combined participation in "Cairo Fashion & Tex" under MAI Scheme with FIEO
- ✓ SRTEPC is organizing Presentation Meetings in Mumbai, Surat and Delhi on 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July'17 respectively to update its member-companies about the forthcoming Fair in Cairo
- ✓ SRTEPC is also deputing an Official of the Council to make an advance visit to Cairo for promotion of buyers to India Pavilion
- ✓ SRTEPC is in regular touch with the Embassy of India in Cairo for the promotion of trade of Indian MMF Textiles to Egypt

- ✓ Both politically and economically, Egypt is well settled, and also very familiar with Indian companies for doing business peacefully

With a view to build a modern Egypt hinging on flexible administrative, productive, and economic bodies that are capable of reacting with the successive international challenges, the Egyptian government has established strong links between production and exportation to form a harmonious scheme within the state-policy aiming at boosting exports, and upgrading national industry through modern international technology and expertise in order to produce high quality competitive market accessible products through a comprehensive trade scheme setting export promotion as a priority.



**EGYPT TEXTILE SECTOR** 

#### Current potential of Egyptian markets of textiles/clothing

Egyptian textile industry is very ancient dating back to the age of the pharaohs. The country is the pivot for vertically integrated textile industry in the Middle Eastern region. The country involves complete production process right from the cultivation of cotton, to the making of yarns, fabrics, and readymade apparels. Textile and apparel industry is the second largest sector, next to agro, and plays a major role in shaping the Egyptian economy.



Textile Industry Overview

Apparel sector accounts for 3% of GDP and 27% of the industrial output. 25% of the total industry is focused on textile production, of which 12% are engaged in home textiles, 8% in cotton yarn, and 5% in other textiles. Public sector dominates the production industry with 50% in spinning, 60% in hemming, and 60% in weaving. Private sector owns 90% of the garmenting side of the industry. Spinning and weaving sector is being dominated by the large scale industries with a strong influence of public sector.

As per a research data of 2010, its textile sector consists of 3,243 companies with a total investment of 3.2 billion USD. Textile industries of Egypt produce 315 million apparels, and exports 305,000 tons of cloth and apparel annually. US constitute 80% of the country's export market, followed by EU and Arabian countries comprising the remaining 20%.
