

Professor Fred Wegman

Professor Fred Wegman has extensive experience of research and advisory work on road safety in the Netherlands, Europe and other parts of the world. He gained a MSc-degree from Delft University of Technology in 1972. In 1977, he joined SWOV Institute for Road Safety Research and since April 1999 has been its managing director. Since January 2009, he has been appointed as part-time Professor of Road Safety at the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Geosciences of the Delft University of Technology. He stepped down as SWOV's managing director in 2013 and he is Professor Emeritus since 2014. He was the chairman of several OECD scientific expert groups (residential areas, rural road safety, road safety targets), ETSC working party on Road Safety Performance Indicators, and the SUNflower projects. He is chairing the International Traffic Safety Data and Analysis Group (IRTAD). He is the director of Delft Road Safety Courses. He has been involved in road safety programmes, projects and research in many European countries and in Australia, Colombia, Israel, New Zealand, Nigeria, and South Africa. He is the associate editor of Safety Science, and the co-author of Advancing Sustainable Safety, the National Road Safety Outlook for 2005-2020.
