Ex Amritsar -Dalhousie 02 Night / 03 Days





Day 01: Amritsar - Dalhousie LocalAfter breakfast, check-out from the hotel and drive to Dalhousie. Visit St. John's Church, St. Francis church at Subhash Chowk and St.John's Church at Gandhi Chowk. Subhash Baoli is a picturesque site surrounded by majestic trees and snowcapped peaks, named after Subhash Chandra Bose, the famous Indian freedom fighter, who had spent a lot of time here meditating. Panchpula is a waterfall, and an amazing picnic spot in Dalhousie, surrounded by a cover of fresh, green pine and deodar trees,. The spot where five streams come together. A Samadhi is built near Panchpula in the memory of a great revolutionary, Sardar Ajit Singh (Uncle of Martyr Bhagat Singh), who breathed his last here. Moreover, the pristine water is best enjoyed during monsoon when the water gushes down the falls and the surroundings leave you stupefied. Kalatop Wildlife Sanctuary, located in the picturesque hilly Chambal district of Himachal Pradesh. The name Kalatop means 'black cap', which probably refers to the thick black forest cover on the highest hilltop in the sanctuary. The trekking and hiking trails in the Kalatop Sanctuary offers a pristine, mesmerizing experience with nature and one of the best means to explore the beautiful untouched forests. Day 02: Trip to Khajjiar & ChambaAfter breakfast, drive to Khajjiar to spend the day in what is called India's 'mini-Switzerland'. Khajjiar is among the 160 places in the world that was officially given the title because of its resemblance to the lovely landscapes in Switzerland. The lush green meadows are a photographer's delight. Khajjiar Lake is situated at the centre of the plains.

Day 01: Drive from Amritsar | Dharamshala After breakfast, check out from Amritsar hotel and proceed to Dharamshala—Perhaps one of the best holiday destinations since the time of the British. 

Amritsar is a city in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab, 28 kilometers from the border with Pakistan. At the center of its walled old town, the gilded Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib) is the holiest gurdwara (religious complex) of the Sikh religion. It's at the end of a causeway, surrounded by the sacred Amrit Sarovar tank (lake), where pilgrims bathe.

Today After breakfast checkout from hotel and drive to Amritsar station /Airport drop.



Vaishno Devi Tour 02 Nights / 03 Days Ex-Amritsar



Vaishno Devi is a manifestation of the Hindu Mother Goddess, Devi. The words "Maa" and "Mata" are commonly used in India for mother, and thus are often heavily used in connection with Vaishno Devi. Vaishnavi was formed from the combined energies of Parvati, Lakshmi, and Saraswati.







ITINERARY:

Day 1: Transfers from Amritsar to Katra (255 km / Approx 06 Hours Drive)

Today morning after Breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Katra, the base point of Vaishnodevi. Arrive in Katra and check into your hotel.

Rest of the evening will be free for leisure.

Overnight stay at Katra.

Day 2: Katra - Vaishno Devi Darshans

Today proceed to Mata Vaishno Devi Bhawan- one of the most popular pilgrimage of India situated in Trikuta Hills.

Yatra involves a trek of nearly 14 Kms from Ban Ganga Bridge in Katra. An alternate way to perform darshans is by battery operated cars, ponies/palkis/helicopter.

If time permits, visit Ardhkuwari & Bhairo Temple. Now a ropeway connects Vaishno Devi Bhavan to Bhairo Temple. After visiting the temples, return to the hotel in Katra and relax in your hotel.

Day 3: Departure transfers to Amritsar Airport/Jammu Airport

Today after breakfast, you will be transferred to Amritsar or Jammu Airport/Railway station.
