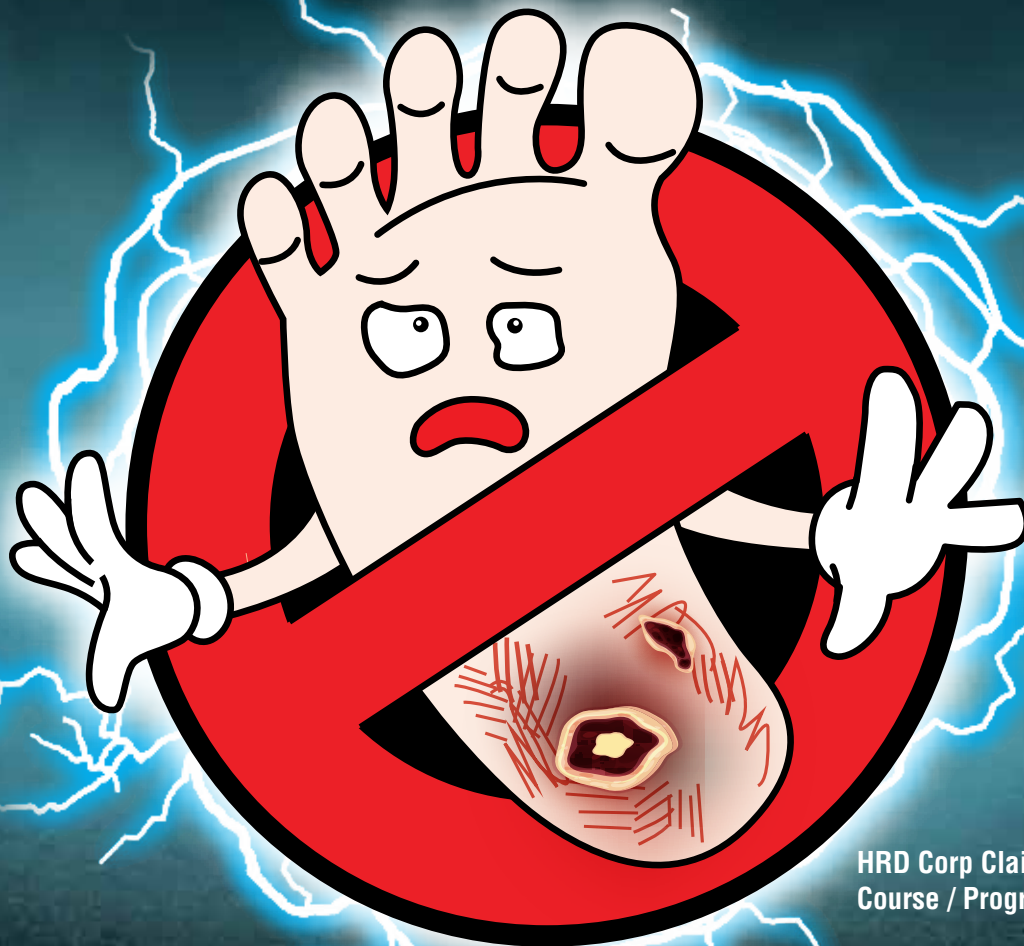

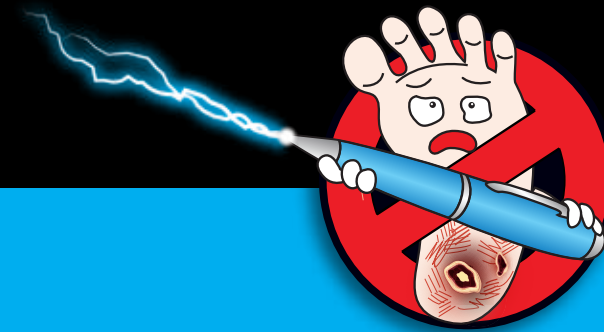

The programme in this book reflects the latest research, innovation, and clinical understandings that unquestionably will shape diabetic foot care in the future.

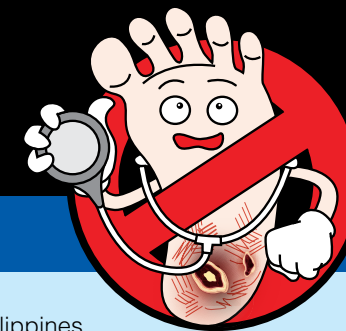
