An obese patient being considered for bariatric surgery and also for future kidney transplant. EGJ outflow obstruction on manometry,

and abnormal acid exposure on pH testing. Concerns on Transplant/Bariatric surgery.

- · Pre-operative physiology testing in bariatric surgery,
- manometric significance of EGJ outflow obstruction.
- The new Chicago classification for manometry, Version 4.
- Reflux & bariatric surgical selection.
