





Persistent EoE in a patient with Barrett's esophagus dysplasia and large hiatal hernia

Presenter of the case:


- Abdullah Shaikh MD. GI Fellow
- A 55 year man with chronic GERD diagnosed to have Barrett's esophagus with low grade dysplasia (Prague C8M8).
- Endoscopic eradication therapy with successful radio frequency ablation, and complete resolution of intestinal metaplasia.
- Intense eosinophilia (> 50/HPF) on surveillance biopsies.
- Multiple inhaled and oral steroid treatments with persistent FoF.




Barrett mucosa




24hr pH image
