A 81 year old patient with reflux, dysphagia and anemia.

Diagnosis of a large type III hiatal hernia confirmed by abdominal CT-Scan.

Emergency admission for pain and vomiting after a paragliding flight. Diaphragmatic hernia with colic content confirmed by CT-Scan.
