Abstract Format

- · Abstract must not be more than 250 words.
- It must not have images, graphs and tables.
- Use numerals to represent numbers except when beginning a sentence.
- All abbreviations must be spelled out on first use.
- Abstract title must be in capital letters. Title should be brief and clearly indicate the content of the abstract.
- The presenting author's name must be FULL and bold.
- · Only abstracts that conform to the given guidelines will be accepted.

Abstract should include:

- All abstracts must be submitted to the MDES 2024 Conference Secretariat by email to <u>secretariat@mdesconference2024.com</u>. Please ensure you check your data carefully before submitting as changes or additions will not be accepted after 7th April 2024.
- Abstracts must be submitted by 7th April 2024. Late submissions or incomplete abstracts will not be accepted.
