Complexities of the GSC require enhanced bilateral and multilateral cooperation which can be approached in many ways:



16 FTAs including CPTPP, RCEP, EVFTA, ATIGA...



26 CMAAs and Protocols on Mutual Assistance



AEO MRAs with ASEAN, ongoing discussions with KCS, China...

5. ROLE OF VN AEO PROGRAMME



POSITIVE IMPACT ON THE NATIONAL ECONOMY AND THE GSC, A COMPARISON BETWEEN 2014 VS 2024

Increase in trade volume **23% vs 36% total trade volume**

Increase in number **24 vs 75 AEOs**

Exporting to large markets with a variety of products , especially in the agriculture sector
