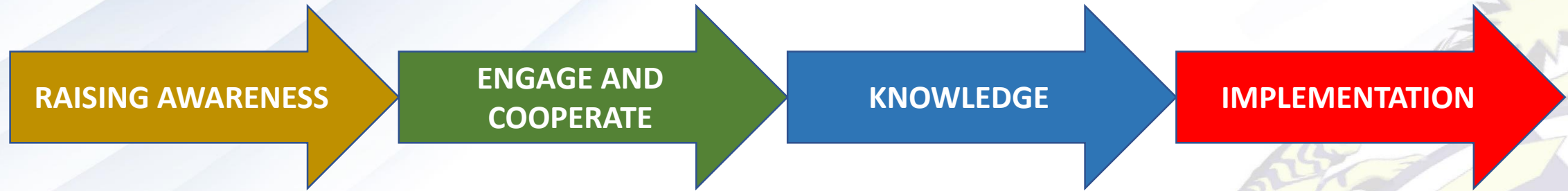

INITIATIVES TO STRENGTHENING INTER-AGENCY COOPERATION



1. Create awareness to OGA on AEO programme under Customs.
1. To explore benefits that OGA could offer.

1. Exploring cooperation options and requirements, including the legal frameworks.
2. Identify Customs and OGA's role or function at border.

1. Knowledge of safety and security programmes of OGA or inter-governmental agencies.
2. Avoidance of duplication in legal framework and procedures.

1. Established working group to streamline and expand the AEO programme.
2. Regular meeting with Working Group to develop National Integrated Checklist.
3. Joint Validation Audit with OGA.



1. Cooperation between Customs and OGA.
2. Support Coordinated Border Management.

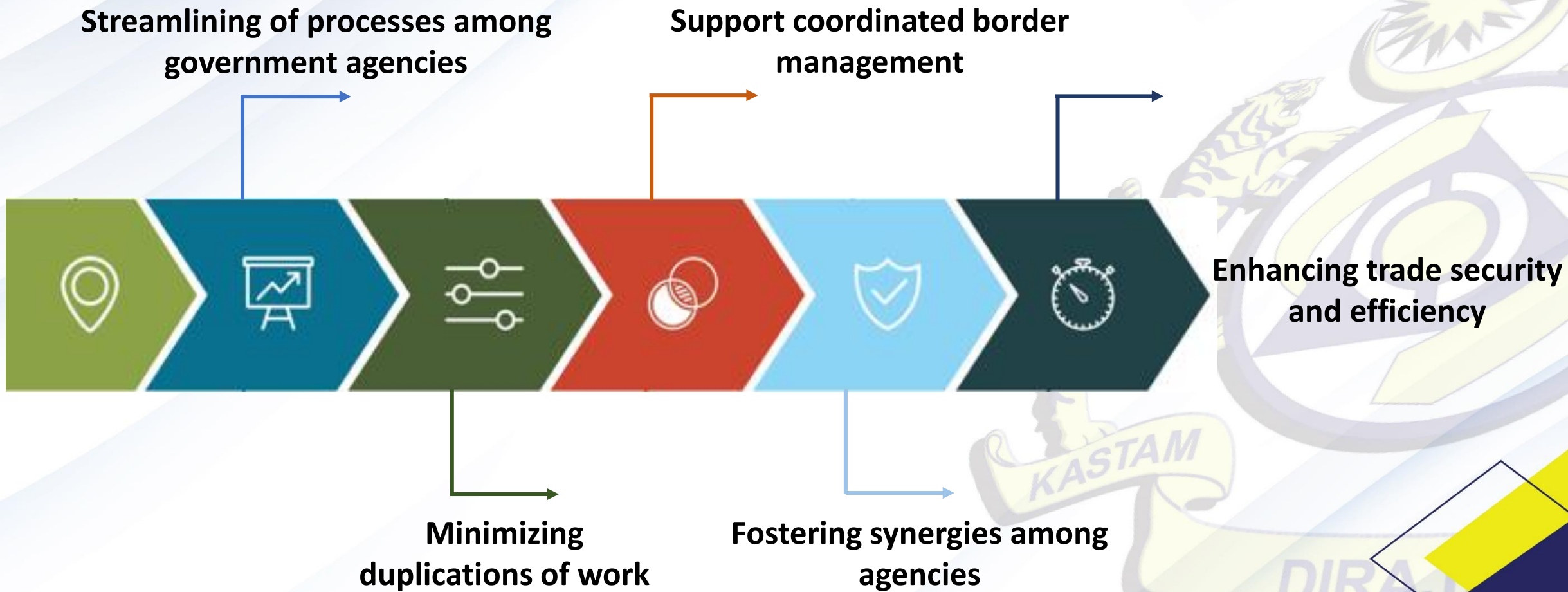
