



IMPLEMENTATION

- Create awareness to OGA on AEO programme under Customs.
- To explore benefits that OGA could offer.
- 1. Exploring cooperation options and requirements, including the legal frameworks.
- 2. Identify Customs and OGA's role or function at border.

- Knowledge of safety and security programmes of OGA or inter-governmental agencies.
- Avoidance of duplication in legal framework and procedures.

- 1. Established working group to streamline and expand the AEO programme.
- Regular meeting with Working Group to develop National Integrated Checklist.
- 3. Joint Validation Audit with OGA.
