- Defined by Trade and Industry Department
- Manufacturing : <100 employees
- Non-manufacturing : <50 employees

SMEs of HKAEO

- As of Apr 2024, HK Customs accredited 85 / FUJIFI
- 18 of them are SMEs



Challenges faced by SMEs in AEO HKAEO Program

- Full compliance with WCO's SAFE Framework of Standards
- Fulfilled all the required security criteria and standards




