



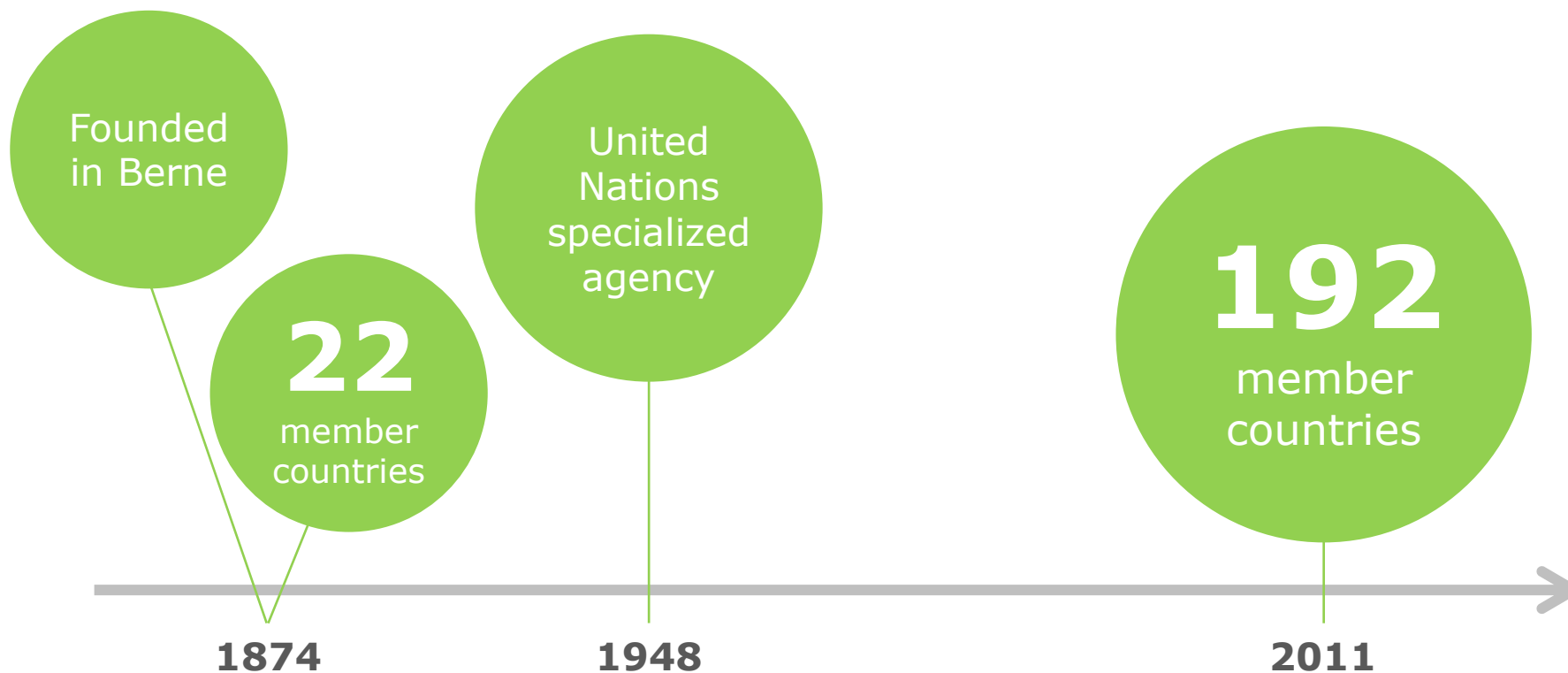

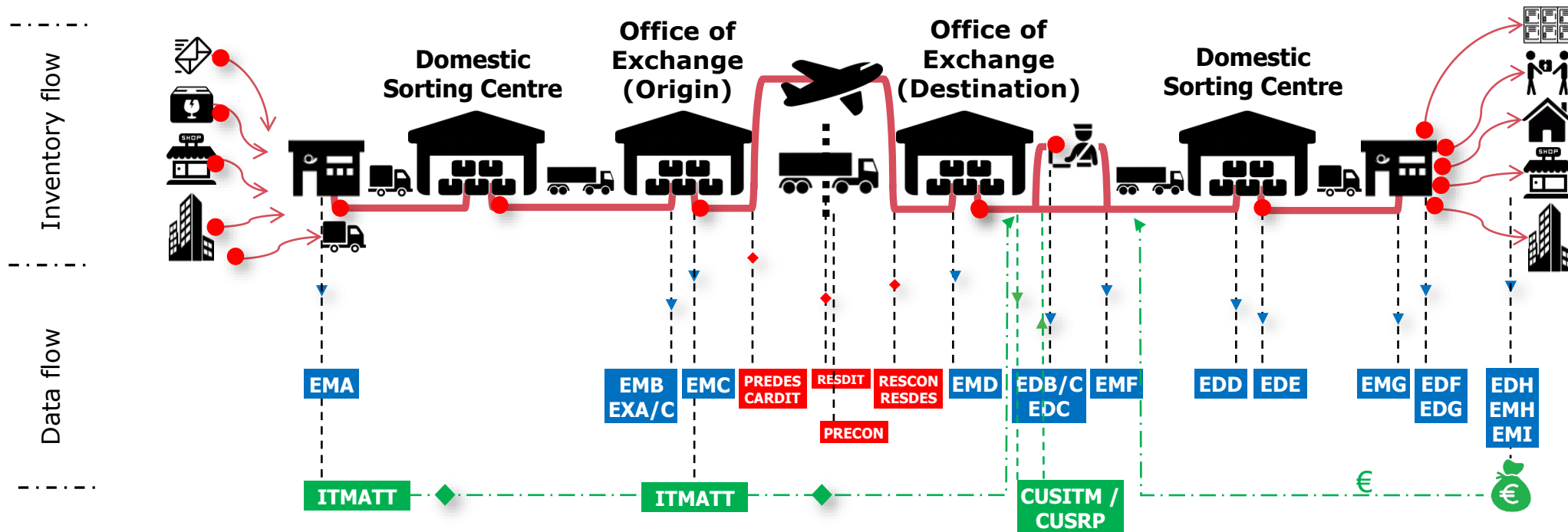


The Universal Postal Union

UPU S58/S59 Security Standards

S58

General security measures

- Risk assessment and security plans
- General physical security measures (perimeter security, lighting, etc.)
- Personnel security and hiring processes/contractor security
- Transportation and conveyance security requirements
- Compliance audit programme and oversight
- Postal security unit

S59

Office of exchange and international airmail security

- General physical custody of international airmail
- Items exempt from screening and items to be screened
- High-risk items
- Screening procedures for mail receptacles/bags
- Alarm resolution of suspicious items and notification procedures
- Measures for mail accepted for carriage on commercial aircraft



UPU Security Standards and WCO AEO

UPU's efforts to align the Security Standards S58.S59 with the WCO Safe Framework of Standards and AEO program



- UPU S58 and S59 updated to align with WCO SAFE Framework
- SAFE Framework:
 - Establishes principles and standards, serving as a minimal threshold for WCO Members
 - recognizes alignment with S58 and S59 guidelines for postal operations' safety and security

allow for a broader recognition of equivalency status among postal operators

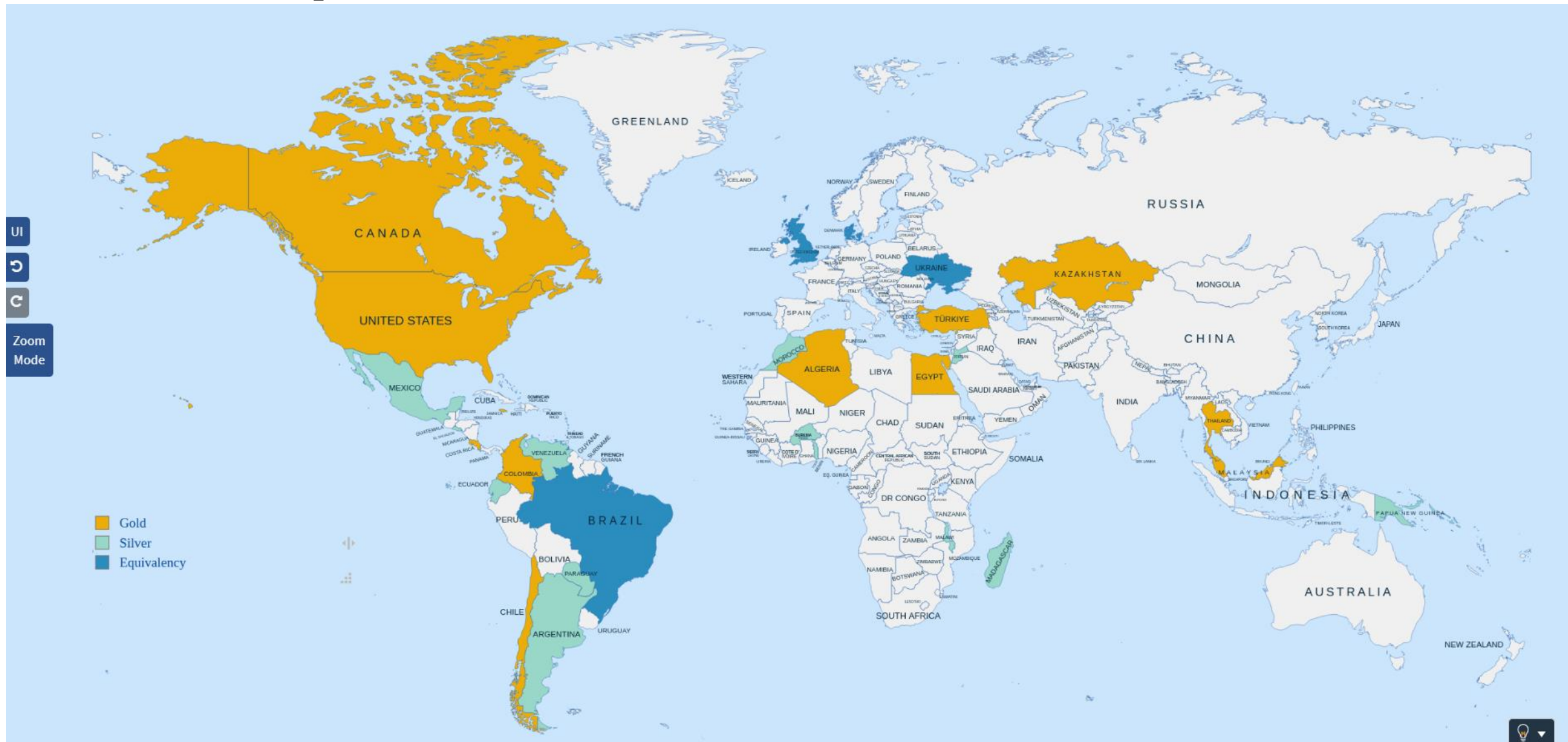

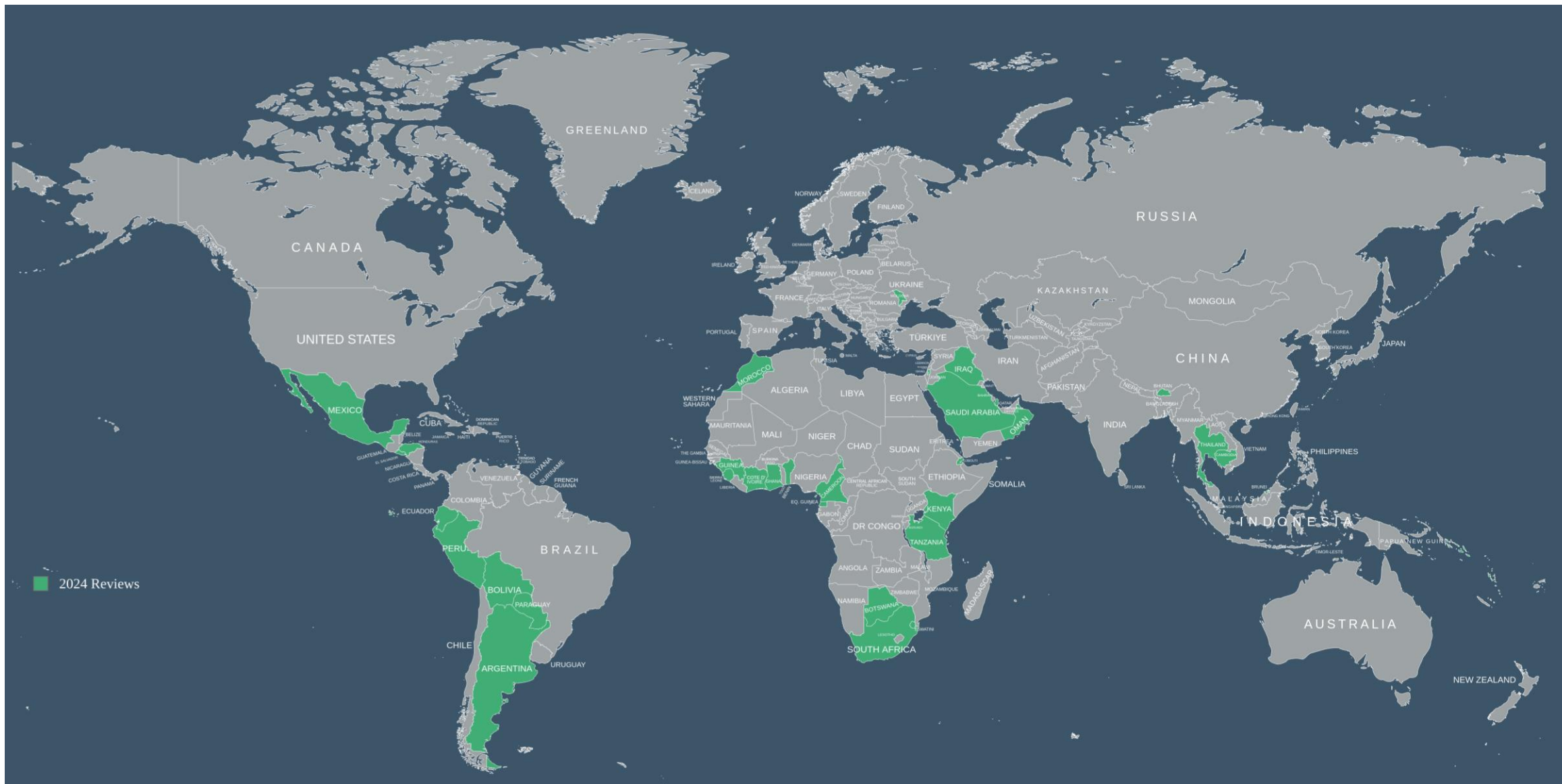
