- 4. A log book maintenance is desirable following the course for future validation and fellowship training and international accreditation.
- 5. One cadaver specimen will be allotted to 2 participants for optimum utilisation
- 6. Certification as Dissector shall be provided at the end of the course.

- 1. Observer shall be attending the course as audience in the lab.
- 2. A Brief Course material encompassing all the techniques shall be handed over to the observers at the start of the course and also shared with them via email prior to attending the course, so that they can come prepared for the same.
- 3. Certification as Observer shall be provided at the end of the course.
