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

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

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### REGULATIONS





Participants must be registered as participants in the 8th APPAC 2024 and already have a registration number.



Participants are still registered as participants in the ORL-HNS residency program or fresh graduates as proven by a certificate from the Head of the Study Program.



The article is the result of original research in the field of Ear, Nose, Throat, Head and Neck surgery and related matters.



The article is an original manuscript that has never been published or registered in any journal.



Articles can be research results or case report (Evidence Based Case Report).



Articles are written in English.

**ABSTRACT SUBMISSION: bit.ly/APPACabstract** 

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### RESEARCH

#### Maximum of 15 pages, consists of:

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- Title: written in a briefly concise, specific, and informative manner. Maximum 14 words (not more than 14), written in sentence case bold (capitalizing only the first word), font 14 Times New Roman.
- Writer's name: contains the writer's full name, no abbreviation, and the institution of the writer's domicile. Should the writers belong to several institutions, give an asterix (\*/\*\*) for complying with their institutions.
- Abstract: Written in a paragraph, consists of background, purpose, method, result, and conclusion. Maximum 250 words. Keywords are written below the abstract (3 - 5 words).
- Article: written with font 12 Times New Roman with line spacing 1.5. Each paragraph is written indented 5 spaces. Articles are written in 2 columns.
- Introduction: written briefly (1-2 pages), explaining the background and purpose of the research. The last paragraph contains the research objectives, can be quoted from previous publications that are considered important.
- Methods: contains an explanation of the material and research methods. Research methods must be clearly described, including subject selection, variable definitions, inclusion and exclusion criteria, test equipment, and statistical tests used. Uncommon methods should have backup references.
- Result: Written in narrative and can be assisted with tables (maximum 5 tables) to accommodate important data and images that can support research results. Writing decimal numbers is separated by a period (.).
- **Discussion:** describe the research results: the meaning or benefits of the research both for the research itself and for clinical applications, as well as a differences and similarities with other research. The final paragraph of the discussion expresses research conclusions and suggestions (if necessary).



**Conclusion:** conclusion and suggestion.

- Acknowledgment: anyone contributing service to this research, should be mentioned briefly.
- **Reference:** written according to Vancouver Style. The number of references should be between 10-30 (not more than 30).



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### CASE REPORT

Written using the evidence-based case report (EBCR) method. Maximum 15 pages, consisting of:

- Title: written concisely, specifically and informatively. Maximum 14 words (no more than 14), written in sentence case bold (capitalizing only the first word), font 14 Times New Roman.
- Writer's name: contains the writer's full name, no abbreviation, and the institution of the writer's domicile. Should the writers belong to several institutions, give an asterix (\*/\*\*) for complying with their institutions.
- Abstract: Written in a paragraph, consists of background, purpose, method, result, and conclusion. Maximum 250 words. Keywords are written below the abstract (3 5 words).
- Introduction: written briefly (1-2 pages) and at the end of the paragraph there is the aim of the case report.
- Case Report: Clinical questions use the PICO (Problem, Index/Intervention/Indicator, Comparison, and Outcome) format.
- Methods: explains in detail the steps for evidence searching which includes sources, keywords for searching for evidence, inclusion and exclusion criteria.
- **Results:** written in narrative form and can be supported by tables and flowcharts of clear evaluation of the selected articles.
- **O Discussion:** Analysis of whether the case is in accordance with the literature
- **Conclusion:** conclusion and suggestion
- **Reference:** written in Vancouver Style. Consists of 10 30 (maximum 30 references).
- Articles: written using Times New Roman font size 12 with 1.5 line spacing. Each paragraph is written indented 5 spaces. Articles are written in 2 columns.

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
