# Get to know the speakers



**Prof Dr Martin Birchall** is professor of laryngology at UCL and a consultant in ENT surgery at the Royal National Ear Nose and Throat and UCL Hospital. He is one of the world leading surgeon and researcher in disorders of voice, swallowing and breathing, and pioneered the use of transplanted tissue, tissue engineering and soft robotics in laryngeal surgery.



**Prof Dr Marc Remacle** is Emeritus Academic Professor of the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Louvain, Belgium. He is a consultant in the Department of ORL and Head & Neck Surgery of CHL, Luxembourg. He is a world renowned laser surgeon and researcher contributing to the advancement of the laser surgery in laryngology.



**Prof Dr Guri Sandhu** is professor of laryngology and the lead for the Airway Reconstruction Unit at Imperial College London which is one of the largest multidisciplinary adult airway services in Europe, achieving National Centre for Airway Reconstruction status. He has pioneered minimally invasive approaches to airway diseases that have reduced morbidity and hospital stays for patients.



**Dr John Rubin** is consultant ear, nose and throat surgeon at The Royal ENT & Eastman Dental Hospitals, London. Dr. Rubin has written extensively, including several books, numerous articles and chapters, and regularly lectures on voice-related topics. He is also a honorary consultant ENT surgeon at the National Hospital for Neurology & Neurosurgery, where he co-chairs the voice and swallowing unit.



**Dr Fauziah Fardizza** from Indonesia is an ORL-HNS consultant with a subspecialty in Laryngology. She is a renowned surgeon locally in Indonesia and ASEAN for her expertise in autologous fat injection laryngoplasty.



**Assist Prof Dr Premsuda Sombuntham** from Thailand is lecturer in Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok, Thailand and consultant in Bumrungrad International Hospital. Her expertise is in voice feminization and is the leading Voice Feminization Specialist at Chettawut Plastic Surgery Center, Bangkok, Thailand.



**Prof Dr Marina Mat Baki** from Malaysia is professor of laryngology and also the Dean of Faculty of Medicine in Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. Her expertise is in laryngeal reinnervation in which she attained her PhD, and collaborates with endocrine surgeons to actively manage iatrogenic acute recurrent laryngeal nerve injury by providing primary intervention.



**Dr Nik Fariza Husna** from Malaysia is medical lecturer in Universiti Sains Malaysia and consultant ORL-HNS Surgeon with fellowship in Laryngology from UCL, London. Her expertise is in airway surgery managing laryngotracheal stenosis where she collaborates with cardiothoracic surgeon to perform long segment tracheal resection and anastomosis.



**Prof Dr Masaany Mansor** from Malaysia is professor of laryngology in Universiti Teknologi Mara and ORL-HNS consultant in Hospital Al Sultan Abdullah with fellowship from Harvard University and Yonsei University. Her expertise is in laryngeal surgery including managing complex upper airway involvement in thyroid malignancy.



**Associate Prof Dr Mawaddah Azman** from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia, Malaysia. She is the head of department of ORL-HNS in Hospital Canselor Tuanku Mukriz. She managed patients with voice disorders particularly spasmodic dysphonia, early laryngeal cancer and various laryngeal diseases, and actively doing numerous outstanding publication and research on the topics.
