1. E-commerce Clearance Scheme



Definition

► WCO Framework of Standards on Cross-border E-commerce

“**Cross-border E-commerce**”: Online selling of goods to consumers and this digital transactions are subject to customs control

► Act on the Consumer Protection in Electronic Commerce (Article 2)

“**E-commerce**”: Buying or selling of goods over an electronic network

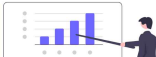
► Framework Act on Electronic Documents and Transactions (Article 2-5)

“**Electronic transaction**”: Transactions of goods and services by digital document in whole or partly

► Customs Act (Article 2-19)

“**E-commerce goods**”: Imported and exported goods traded electronically through online shopping mall (Virtual shopping mall where goods and services are sold and bought via computer or IT system)

Global surge in cross-border e-commerce

1 Rapid growth in global e-commerce market

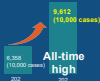
Continued growth expected over the next 5 years
Approximately **75%**↑ increase by 2025 compared to 2020

Global e-commerce market



2 Sharp increase in e-commerce imports

Approximately **106%**↑ increase in 2023 compared to 2020



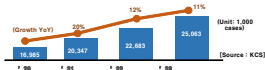
The proportion of e-commerce imports



3 Continued increase in e-commerce users

In 2023, 25,063 thousand users, a **48%**↑ increase from 16,985 thousand users in 2020

E-Commerce Exclusive Clearance System Project Outline

Point1

New declaration form

Add items on the declaration form to declare the e-commerce businesses involved, remove other unnecessary items

→ Improving Current Import declaration form to suit E-commerce trading



Point2

Supply chain-based risk management system

Expedite clearance of goods for E-commerce traders who provide transaction information to Customs Agency

→ Active support for the people to quickly receive their goods purchased directly from overseas



Point3

The Personal Authentication System

Adopt Identification process when ordering e-commerce products, (using QR code, biometrics)

→ Eliminating the fear of personal customs unique code theft



Point4

Public service on e-commerce

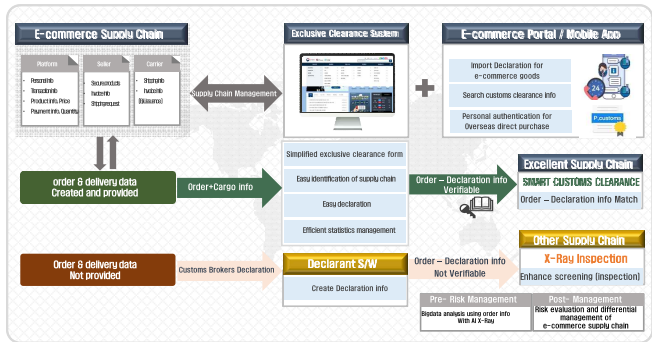
Establish online portal and mobile apps for customs clearance tracking and real-time customer service

→ Provision of one-stop service related E-commerce
