3. Location of the exhibition booth will be allocated on first-come, first-served basis with priority given to the major sponsors.
4. The LCC reserves the right to re-arrange the exhibition floor plan or any part there of any time.
5. Sponsors have to insure their own equipment and display from any accidental damage at the congress venue and exhibition hall, as these are not insured by the organizer.
6. No sale in cash or credit of products and services shall be allowed at the exhibition. However, booking could be done for delivery at a later date. The LCC shall in no way be responsible for any tax liability incurred for any sale / booking undertaken by the exhibitors.

### **Force Majeure:**
