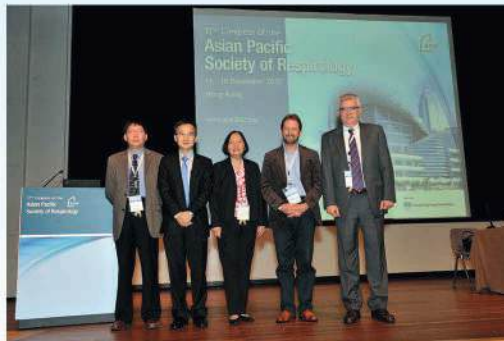
"APSR 2025: Solidarity in Lung Health"
