

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Asia Pacific Society of Infection Control (APSIC) has established **Infection Prevention and Control Nursing scholarships** to promote ongoing training and learning opportunities for nurses working in the field of infection prevention and control in healthcare settings in the Asia Pacific Region. The scholarship will facilitate the successful applicant's attendance at a forthcoming international Asia Pacific Society of Infection Control (APSIC) Congress meeting. Attendance at the congress will further their knowledge and skills and offer networking opportunities with their peers.

Five APSIC Infection Prevention and Control Nursing scholarships will be awarded each calendar year.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a resident of an Asia Pacific country See Appendix 1
- Applicants must be a nurse working in the field of infection prevention and control, in a healthcare setting, in an ASIA Pacific country for at least one year (parttime or fulltime)
- Applicants must not have received an APSIC Infection Prevention and Control Nursing scholarship within the last 5 years
- Applicants must submitted an abstract for the congress scientific program as per abstract submission guidelines on the congress webpage
- Applicants must complete the application form See Appendix 2
- Applications must forward the following documents with the application form to the Secretary General of APSIC:
 - A short Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume
 - A covering letter of no more than <u>one page</u> describing how the scholarship will further your knowledge, skills and professional development in infection prevention and control.
 - A letter from your manager/supervisor or colleague working in the field supporting your application and
 - A digital photo for display at the APSIC Congress (consent for use of the photo is implied in providing your signature)

Based on the selection criteria all applications will be assessed by the Asia Pacific Society of Infection Control (APSIC) Executive Committee and the decision of the Committee is final.

Applications for the APSIC Infection Prevention and Control Nursing scholarship close on the 30th of September each calendar year.

SCHOLARSHIP INCLUSION

Successful applicants of the **APSIC Infection Prevention and Control Nursing scholarship** will receive the following:

- A full complimentary registration (including attendance at a pre-conference workshop) to a forthcoming APSIC Congress, which is held every 2 years.
- Funding to support accommodation and travel expenses (i.e. return economy airfare only) up to a cap of USD\$1000 will be provided upon acceptance of the candidate for the award.

Note: The final funding amount will be at the discretion of the APSIC Executive Committee and upon receipt of the documents detailing planned accommodation and travel expenses.
