Declaration of origin: self-certification

- ❖ Facilitates trade:
 - Simpler: made-out by the exporter itself;
 - Reduce administrative burden and costs.
- ❖ Competent authorities, chambers of commerce and other third parties are not involved in the origin certification.
- ❖ Exporters shall include a text / statement in a [commercial] document.



Declaration of origin: self-certification

In EU trade arrangements, self-certification can be used by:

- Approved exporters;
- **Registered** exporters; or
- Any exporter for exports of originating products below not exceeding a given value.



The EU's Registered Exporter System

- ❖ Exporters are **registered** in database by the competent authorities:
 - ✓ access to certain preferential trade agreements;
 - ✓ declare preferential origin indicating their REX number

The exporter ... (Number of Registered Exporter (2), (3), (4)) of the products covered by this document declares that, except where otherwise clearly indicated, these products are of ... preferential origin (5) according to rules of origin of the Generalised System of Preferences of the European Union and that the origin criterion met is ... (6).

- ❖ Exporters are **monitored**
 - ✓ **Modification and revocation** of registration.

The whole process is **digitalized**.

Registration of exporters



1. The exporter **fills** in an application and **submits** to his competent authorities: Trader Portal (for EU exporters) or <https://customs.ec.europa.eu/rex-pa-ui/> (for non-EU);
2. If the application is **complete**, the competent authorities assign a REX number, a registration date and a validity date;
3. Data **publicly** available depending on consent given;
4. Online **validation** of the REX number.

Strengths of the EU's REX system

- **Individual and unique REX number** assigned to each exporter → improves traceability;
- **Regular control and monitoring** of the registered exporters based on risk analysis;
- Exporters shall **regularly provide** to their competent authorities the list of declarations of origin made out;
- Possibility of **revoking** the registration in the REX system (e.g. non-compliance, fraud).



Application of the EU's REX system

- **112.111** exporters registered in the EU to benefit from 10 trade agreements;
- **Over 83.000** exporters registered outside the EU:
 - ✓ 82.701 in 65 beneficiaries of the EU's GSP/EBA;
 - ✓ 249 in 12 Overseas countries and territories of the EU;
 - ✓ 1.608 in 4 countries enjoying an Economic Partnership Agreements:
 - *Côte d'Ivoire (396), Madagascar (994), Seychelles (18), Zimbabwe (200)*



Declarations of origin - Digitalization

- **Electronic submission** together with customs declaration allowed by Union Custom Code;
- Documents can be kept in **electronic format**;
- Possible areas of **future work**:
 - Enhance reliability:
 - ✓ authenticity of DO;
 - ✓ further publicly available information, e.g. listing companies with delegated powers to issue DO
 - Work on centralizing the system for verification purposes.
