

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE AWARD OF FELLOW OF INDIAN COLLEGE OF CRITICAL CARE MEDICINE (FICCM - 2025)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Candidates can apply online through ISCCM Website and payment for the application is online.

THE APPLICATION FEES IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

Last date of application – September 30, 2025.

How is the selection for FICCM done?

Candidates are screened on three criteria.

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

1. Name of the candidate: First Name Middle Name
Surname (Family Name)
2. ISCCM membership number (Life Member of ISCCM for at least past 5 years)
3. Current Affiliation
4. Current Designation
5. Post Graduate Qualification: (please attach proof)
6. Sub-specialty qualification in Critical Care if any: (please attach proof)
7. Percentage of time spent in Critical Care in daily practice: (please attach self attested declaration and a letter from the head of the current institute)
8. Referrees: i)

Please attach reference letters from **TWO** existing Fellows of the College

NECESSARY CRITERIA

- 1, Formal Qualification in Critical Care Medicine (IDCCM / IFCCM / FNB / DrNB / DM/ AB-CCM/ EDIC / CCST (UK) / FJFICM) – Tick relevant qualification and attach self attested copy of the Certificate
2. If not formally qualified in Critical Care Medicine, please attach a letter from the head of the Institute / Hospital mentioning that the candidate has been practicing Critical Care Medicine for the past 20 years (applicable for those applying for the first time after 2023)

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ADDITIONAL CRITERIA

1. Number of years of experience after qualification in Critical Care Medicine. (Proof(s) required from Head(s) of Institute
2. Duration of experience as a teacher in Critical Care Medicine (Certificate from Indian College of Critical Care Medicine / University). If you have been a teacher for a non Critical Care specialty in the past, separate certificate may be attached
3. a. Number of publications in indexed journals (Medline, PubMed Central, Citation index, Sciences Citation Index Expanded (SCIE), Embase, Scopus, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) as **FIRST, CORRESPONDING or LAST (SENIOR) AUTHOR**. Please submit proof in Pubmed Citation Style and attach the PDFs
b. Number of Text book chapters as First Author or Last Author. Please provide proof in Vancouver referencing style and attach the PDFs
4. Number of years as Critical Care Examiner and number of examinations attended
5. Contribution to Critical Care at local, national and international level
