- There were record 303 registrations for the pre-conference workshops and main conference. This was again a new record. The theme of this *Confotainment* was 'Bespoke Intensive Care: One size doesn't fit all'. Which was to promote and insist on practicing to customize and tailor made critical care in our ICU.
- So this DCCS 2022 17th annual conference was a three day event with first day of pre-conference workshops and two days of main event or main conference. A new term "confotainment" was coined for this three day event, because it was drafted very differently. It was a righteous mixture of academics and entertainment. First day that is 18th was pre conference workshops, we had three different pre conference workshops in three different places, for the first time in the history of DCCS, Innovations in Critical Care Medicine workshop was organized at Fortis Escorts Heart Institute, Okhla Road, New Delhi.
