Author should be ready to present during poster session. Author should be ready for discussion for his/her work at the schedule time during virtual conference.

Scientific committee will be happy to advise & help you in preparing your paper and final computer slide presentations, if selected. The presentation will be on virtual mode during allotted time. Time for each scientific paper presentation will be restriction to 8 minutes with additional 2 minutes for question and answers.
