Assalamualaikum Warahmatullahi Taala Wabarakatuh  
dan Salam Malaysia MADANI,



Bersyukur kita ke hadrat Allah S.W.T kerana dengan limpah kurnia-NYA, maka kita berpeluang untuk sama-sama berkumpul sempena Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan Yayasan Pencegahan Jenayah Malaysia (MCPF) Kali Ke-31.

Pertamanya, saya ingin merakamkan ucapan terima kasih kepada barisan kepimpinan MCPF di semua peringkat yang telah merangka dan menjalankan pelbagai program pencegahan jenayah dengan melibatkan pelbagai agensi yang lain selari dengan objektif penubuhan MCPF.

Jenayah dan kegiatan jenayah masih membimbangkan rakyat sungguh pun kadar indeks jenayah terus menurun sejak beberapa tahun kebelakangan ini. Untuk mengharapkan sebuah negara bebas mutlak daripada jenayah adalah mustahil, tetapi apa yang mungkin boleh dilakukan adalah dengan mengambil semua langkah yang perlu untuk terus mengurangkan kejadian jenayah atau untuk mencegahnya. Pencegahan jenayah adalah usaha yang membabitkan semua pihak dan memerlukan disiplin serta tindakan bersepudu.

Dewasa kini, kerajaan memberi perhatian serius terhadap isu Anti Pemerdagangan Orang dan Penyeludupan Migran (ATIPSOM) selain jenayah siber yang menjadi ancaman kepada keselamatan negara. Kerajaan melalui pelbagai agensi penguatkuasaan telah meningkatkan kempen-kempen kesedaran berbentuk pendidikan kepada masyarakat, namun masih ramai menjadi mangsa kepada jenayah tersebut. Di sini, MCPF juga boleh memainkan peranan dengan membantu pihak berkuasa menjalankan program-program kesedaran secara berterusan di semua peringkat.

MCPF yang berusia 30 tahun sudah memiliki cawangan di peringkat negeri dan daerah. Ianya amat bagus untuk MCPF meningkatkan pelaksanaan program pencegahan jenayah di semua peringkat. Cabaran masa kini tidak sama seperti 30 tahun yang lepas. MCPF perlu memiliki kekuatan dan anjakan paradigma untuk menandingi permasalahan yang dihadapi oleh negara khususnya dalam pencegahan jenayah. *Mindset* lama perlu diubah mengikut peredaran masa.

Saya amat berharap MCPF di setiap peringkat dapat merancang dan melaksanakan program-program pencegahan yang berimpak tinggi bagi membantu pihak berkuasa mengurangkan kadar jenayah dalam negara.

#### 1. PENDAHULUAN

- 1.1 Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan MCPF Kali Ke-29 dan Ke-30 dimulakan dengan ucapan Pengacara Majlis, nyanyian lagu Negaraku dan bacaan doa.

#### 2. UCAPAN ALUAN YB PENGERUSI MCPF

- 2.1 YB Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution bin Ismail mengucapkan ribuan terima kasih kepada semua yang hadir pada Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan Kali Ke-29 dan Ke-30 pada hari ini.

**Makluman**

- 2.2 Beliau memaklumkan ini merupakan kali pertama beliau mempengerusikan Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan MCPF, setelah mempengerusikan Mesyuarat EXCO MCPF Bilangan 1-2023/2026 baru-baru ini.

**Makluman**

- 2.3 YB Penggerusi merakamkan ucapan penghargaan kepada YAB Perdana Menteri, Dato' Seri Anwar bin Ibrahim selaku Penaung MCPF kerana memberi kepercayaan kepada beliau untuk menerajui Yayasan ini.

**Makluman**

- 2.4 YB Pengerusi memaklumkan bahawa MCPF telah diasaskan oleh YABhg. Tun Mohammed Hanif bin Omar pada tahun 1993 adalah setelah menyedari bahawa perlunya sebuah organisasi bebas bagi memberi kesedaran umum tentang pencegahan jenayah dan keselamatan komuniti.

**Makluman**

- 2.5 YB Pengerusi memaklumkan bahawa ucapan pembukaan beliau pada hari ini adalah memfokuskan kepada mengukuhkan disiplin organisasi yang bermula daripada barisan kepimpinan MCPF. Tiga (3) perkara yang perlu dititikberatkan serta menjadi penanda aras dalam memastikan kejayaan MCPF dalam mencapai objektifnya iaitu pengurangan dalam kadar jenayah, perasaan lebih selamat dalam komuniti dan *cost effectiveness*.

Tambah beliau lagi, apabila kehidupan semakin mencabar, jenayah menjadi semakin kompleks. Namun, jenayah masih berlebar dalam lima (5) kategori yang sama iaitu *community crime*, *violence crime*, *white collar crime*, *cyber crime* dan *drug crime*. *Drug crime* adalah musuh negara yang telah berdekad lamanya. *Cyber crime* pula adalah satu (1) jenayah baru yang sedang menular dengan pantas dan kerajaan sedang menggubal undang-undang bagi mengawal selia segala isu berkaitan jenayah *cyber crime*.

**Makluman**

- 2.6 YB Pengerusi seterusnya memaklumkan bahawa organisasi yang mantap, kukuh serta jelas tentang bidang tugasnya bermula daripada kepimpinan yang baik dan hala tuju yang jelas. Oleh itu, beliau memohon kepada semua ahli untuk membuat pilihan yang terbaik semasa sesi pemilihan Ahli Majlis Eksekutif kelak dan setelah pemilihan selesai, beliau meminta semua ahli untuk duduk dalam satu pasukan bagi menentukan hala tuju dan rencana yang ingin diperjuangkan.

**Makluman**

- 2.7 Menurut YB Pengerusi, beliau yakin dan percaya bahawa setiap ahli mempunyai kepakaran, kebolehan dan kemampuan tersendiri; di mana semua ini adalah adunan yang terbaik bagi memperkuuhkan serta memperkasakan lagi MCPF di setiap peringkat. Ditambah pula dengan kehadiran tokoh-tokoh besar di dalam MCPF seperti YBhg. Tan Sri Syed

Hamid bin Tan Sri Syed Jaafar Albar, YABhg. Tun Mohammed Hanif bin Omar dan YBhg. Tan Sri Datuk Seri Panglima Lee Lam Thye; beliau amat yakin bahawa MCPF akan dapat membantu bukan sahaja pihak kerajaan, malahan orang awam dalam isu-isu berkaitan pencegahan jenayah dan keselamatan komuniti.

- 2.8 YB Pengerusi juga memaklumkan bahawa beliau yakin dengan kemampuan kepimpinan barisan Ahli Majlis Eksekutif sedia ada dan juga yang bakal dilantik, serta ahli-ahli yang hadir pada hari ini dan oleh itu beliau sedia memberikan sokongan sepenuhnya kepada MCPF.

- 2.9 Akhir kata, YB Pengerusi merasmikan Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan MCPF Kali Ke-29 dan Ke-30 dengan lafaz bismillah dan berharap mesyuarat pada hari ini berjalan dengan lancar dan jayanya.

**3. SESI PENYERAHAN KAD KEAHLIAN SEUMUR HIDUP KEHORMAT**

- 3.1 Penyampaian kad keahlian seumur hidup kehormat kepada dua (2) tokoh yang telah banyak berjasa kepada MCPF iaitu YBhg. Tan Sri Syed Hamid bin Tan Sri Syed Jaafar Albar dan YABhg. Tun Mohammed Hanif bin Omar.

**Program-Program Berbentuk Pendidikan dan Kesedaran Berhubung Jenayah Siber Secara Berterusan Melibatkan Semua Lapisan Masyarakat**

- 5.1 Setiausaha Kehormat memaklumkan bahawa MCPF mengambil maklum saranan YB Pengurus untuk memberi lebih perhatian terhadap jenayah siber. Untuk itu, pelbagai inisiatif dalam memberi kesedaran berhubung jenayah siber telah dilaksanakan. Antaranya Kempen Pencegahan Jenayah Komersil (Awie Ride) 2022, Projek Poster Anti-Scam Pulau Pinang, Kajian Keberkesanan Kempen Anti-Scam, perkongsian berhubung jenayah scam di dalam buletin MCPF dan lain-lain lagi.

**Makluman**

**Sokongan YB Pengurus Terhadap Pelanjutan Tempoh Penggal Ahli Exco Menjadi Tiga (3) Tahun**

- 5.2 Setiausaha Kehormat memaklumkan bahawa pelanjutan tempoh penggal bagi ahli Exco daripada dua (2) tahun kepada tiga (3) tahun telah dibentangkan dan dipersetujui semasa Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan Ke-28. Jabatan Pendaftaran Pertubuhan Malaysia (JPPM) telah dimaklumkan dan meluluskan pelanjutan tempoh penggal ahli Exco berkenaan yang melibatkan pindaan Artikel 8 (e) Perlembagaan MCPF.

**Makluman**

**Semakan Semula Artikel 15 Perlombagaan MCPF Oleh Penasihat Undang-Undang Seperti Yang Diminta Oleh YB Pengerusi**

- 5.3 Setiausaha Kehormat memaklumkan bahawa sebuah jawatankuasa khas telah ditubuhkan bagi menyemak Artikel 15 Perlombagaan MCPF (dan lain-lain artikel yang berkaitan keahlian) di mana didapati tiada pindaan diperlukan. Jawatankuasa tersebut mendapati bahawa:
- 5.3.1 Kategori keahlian yang sedia ada adalah bersesuaian dan memadai.
  - 5.3.2 Yuran keahlian adalah berpatutan.
  - 5.3.3 Pemecatan seseorang ahli berdasarkan situasi tertentu dinyatakan dengan jelas. Ahli diberikan hak untuk merayu ke atas keputusan Majlis Eksekutif (berkaitan pemecatan).

**Penyertaan Semua Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Perhubungan Negeri Dalam Mesyuarat Exco Bagi Berkongsi Input dan Pandangan**

- 5.4 Setiausaha Kehormat memaklumkan bahawa memandangkan tiada Mesyuarat Exco yang dilaksanakan selepas Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan Ke-28, maka perancangan ini telah tertangguh dan akan dilaksanakan bagi Mesyuarat Exco yang akan datang.

**Tajaan Sebanyak RM50,000 Oleh Tan Sri Datuk Robert Phang Miow Sin Bagi Menjalankan Kajian Untuk Mempromosikan Kesedaran Pencegahan Jenayah**

- 5.5 Setiausaha Kehormat memaklumkan bahawa penajaan sebanyak RM50,000 yang ingin disumbangkan oleh Tan Sri Datuk Robert Phang Miow Sin bagi menjalankan kajian untuk mempromosikan kesedaran pencegahan jenayah akan dibincangkan dalam Mesyuarat Exco yang akan datang.

**Cadangan Agar Bendera MCPF Direka Mengikut Spesifikasi Yang Sepatutnya**

- 5.6 Setiausaha Kehormat memaklumkan bahawa contoh bendera MCPF akan dibentangkan dan dibincangkan semasa sesi *retreat* bersama ahli-ahli Exco kelak.

**6. MEMBENTANGKAN DAN MELULUSKAN LAPORAN TAHUNAN 2021 DAN 2022**

- 6.1 Setiausaha Kehormat telah membentangkan buku Laporan Tahunan 2021 dan 2022 sepetimana yang telah diedarkan kepada semua ahli mesyuarat.
- 6.2 Laporan tersebut telah dicadangkan sah oleh Encik V.Rajoo A/L Kalimuthu (No. Ahli: 101987) dan telah disokong oleh Encik Mohd Fadzil bin Abd Jabbar (No. Ahli: 102319).

**Makluman**

**7. MEMBENTANGKAN DAN MELULUSKAN LAPORAN PENYATA KEWANGAN TAHUN BERAKHIR 31 DISEMBER 2021 DAN 31 DISEMBER 2022**

- 7.1 Tan Sri Datuk Eddy Chen Lok Loi selaku Bendahari MCPF telah membentangkan Laporan Penyata Kewangan Tahun Berakhir 31 Disember 2021 dan 31 Disember 2022. Laporan telah diaudit oleh juru audit bertauliah iaitu Deloitte PLT.

**Makluman**

- 7.2 Beliau memaklumkan bagi tahun berakhir 31 Disember 2021, jumlah pendapatan adalah sebanyak RM284,595 dan perbelanjaan berjumlah RM486,567 iaitu defisit sebanyak RM201,972. Manakala jumlah *cash and cash equivalents* dilaporkan berjumlah RM6,042,009.

**Makluman**

- 7.3 Manakala bagi tahun berakhir 31 Disember 2022 pula, jumlah pendapatan adalah sebanyak RM1,326,976 dan perbelanjaan berjumlah RM1,502,013 iaitu defisit sebanyak RM175,037. Manakala jumlah *cash and cash equivalents* dilaporkan berjumlah RM6,091,405.

**Makluman**

- 7.4 Tan Sri Datuk Eddy Chen Lok Loi mencadangkan agar ahli Majlis Eksekutif yang akan dilantik kelak untuk mengadakan aktiviti *fund raising* pada tahun 2023 bagi menampung kos pengoperasian MCPF.

**Makluman**

- 7.5 Prof. Madya Dr. Geshina Ayub binti Mat Saad (No. Ahli 101996) memohon penjelasan berkenaan kos penggajian (*Payroll inclusive of EPF and SOCSO*) yang meningkat daripada RM264,875 pada tahun 2021 kepada RM366,892 pada tahun 2022. Tan Sri Datuk Eddy Chen Lok Loi memaklumkan bahawa pada tahun 2020, MCPF mempunyai enam (6) kakitangan Sekretariat, di mana beberapa kakitangan telah berhenti di antara penghujung tahun 2020 dan sekitar tahun 2021; dan diganti dengan beberapa kakitangan baharu pada tahun 2022.

**Makluman**

- 7.6 Datuk Seri Dr. Chai Kee Kan (No. Ahli: 102069) memaklumkan bahawa sekiranya jumlah bagi *Payroll inclusive of EPF and SOCSO* bagi tahun 2022 iaitu RM366,892 dibahagikan dengan 12 bulan, jumlah bulanan bagi *Payroll inclusive of EPF and SOCSO* adalah sekitar RM30,000 sebulan. Dengan enam (6) orang kakitangan, purata gaji bulanan bagi setiap kakitangan (termasuk caruman EPF yang perlu dibayar oleh MCPF) adalah sekitar RM5,000. Jika ditolak caruman EPF yang perlu dibayar oleh MCPF sebanyak 12% sebulan bagi setiap kakitangan, purata gaji setiap kakitangan adalah sekitar RM4,5000. Pada hemat beliau, jumlah tersebut adalah berpatutan.

**Makluman**

7.7 Prof. Madya Dr. Geshina Ayub binti Mat Saad juga memohon penjelasan berkenaan kos perbelanjaan bagi *Seminar, conference and workshop expenses* di mana beliau menyatakan bahawa dalam pemahaman beliau, setiap negeri mempunyai had maksimum peruntukan sebanyak RM10,000 untuk satu (1) program. Tan Sri Datuk Eddy Chen Lok Loi memaklumkan bahawa tiada had maksimum peruntukan bagi sesuatu program seperti dinyatakan tersebut. Setiap negeri diberikan peruntukan tahunan sebanyak samada RM30,000 atau RM50,000. Beliau juga memaklumkan bahawa Penyata Kewangan yang dibentangkan semasa Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan adalah maklumat perakaunan tahunan MCPF secara keseluruhan, dan tidak merangkumi perincian bagi setiap transaksi. Penyata Kewangan yang dibentangkan juga telah diaudit oleh juru audit bertauliah. Beliau meminta Prof. Madya Dr. Geshina Ayub binti Mat Saad atau mana-mana ahli yang ingin mengetahui mengenai segala transaksi perakaunan dengan lebih terperinci untuk hadir ke Pejabat Sekretariat bagi menyemak segala rekod perakaunan.

**Makluman**

7.8 Encik Mah Yoke Keong (No. Ahli 102350) mencadangkan agar Buku Laporan Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan dapat dihantar kepada semua ahli dalam empat belas (14) hari sebelum tarikh Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan bagi memberi masa kepada ahli-ahli untuk menyemak segala laporan yang dilampirkan.



**Opinion**

**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS  
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2023**

**1. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The principal objectives of the Foundation are to contribute to the enhancement of effective measures for crime prevention and the treatment of offenders, and to promote public awareness of and participation in crime prevention efforts. The Foundation is a non-profit organisation.

The total number of employees of the Foundation as at 31 December 2023 was 6 (2022: 9).

The registered office of the Foundation is B-3A-13 Blok B Level 4 Unit 13, Megan Avenue II, Jalan Yap Kwan Seng, 50450 Kuala Lumpur.

The financial statements were approved and authorised for issue in accordance with a resolution of the Executive Council dated 18 March 2024.

**2. BASIS OF PREPARATION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

The financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared in accordance with the Malaysian Private Entities Reporting Standard ("MPERS") issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB").

**3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**Basis of Accounting**

The financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

**Income Recognition**

Income is recognised to the extent that it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Foundation and the revenue can be reliably measured. Income is measured at the fair value of consideration received or receivable.

**(i) Income from donation and entrance fee**

Income from donation and entrance fee is recognised on a receipt basis.

**(ii) Annual subscription fee**

Annual subscription fee income is recognised on an accrual basis.

**(iii) Interest income**

Interest income is recognised on an accrual basis.

**(iv) Dividend income**

Dividend income is recognised when the right to receive payment is established.

**Tax Expense**

The Foundation is exempted from taxation under the Paragraph 13, Schedule 6 of the Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1967.

**Foreign Currency**

Functional currency is the currency of the primary economic environment in which the entity operates.

The financial statements are presented in Ringgit Malaysia ("RM"), which is the Foundation's functional and presentation currency. The Foundation determines its functional currency as RM and measures its results and financial position in that functional currency.

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are translated and recorded at the rates of exchange prevailing at the respective dates of transaction. At the end of each reporting year, monetary items denominated in foreign currencies are retranslated at the rates prevailing at the end of the year. Non-monetary items that are measured at their historical cost amounts continue to be translated at their respective historical rates and are not retranslated.

All exchange differences arising on settled transactions and on unsettled monetary items are recognised in profit or loss in the year.

### **Employee Benefits**

#### **(i) Short-term employee benefits**

Wages, salaries, paid annual leave and sick leave, bonuses and non-monetary benefits are recognised as an expense in the year in which the associated services are rendered by the employees of the Foundation.

#### **(ii) Defined contribution plans**

The Foundation's contributions to the Employees Provident Fund are recognised in the statement of income and expenditure in the financial year to which they relate. Once the contributions have been paid, the Foundation has no further payment obligations and other staff benefits.

### **Impairment of Assets**

The carrying amounts of plant and equipment are reviewed at the end of the reporting year to determine whether there is any indication of impairment. If such an indication exists, the assets' recoverable amounts are estimated. An impairment loss is recognised whenever the carrying amount of an asset or its cash-generating unit exceeds its recoverable amount. All impairment losses are charged to the profit or loss.

The recoverable amount of an asset is the higher of its fair value less costs to sell and its value-in-use. In assessing value in use, the estimated future cash flows are discounted to their present value using a pre-tax discount rate that reflects current market assessments of the time value of money and the risks specific to the asset.

An impairment loss is only reversed to the extent that the asset's carrying amount does not exceed the carrying amount that would have been determined, net of depreciation or amortisation, if no impairment loss had been recognised. All reversals are recognised in the statement of comprehensive income.

### **Plant and Equipment**

Plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses.

The straight line method is used to write off the cost of the assets over the term of their estimate useful lives at the following principal annual rates:

Building	2%
Computer	25%
Office furniture, fittings and renovation	25%
Motor vehicles	25%
Office equipment	25%

Gain or loss arising from the disposal of an asset is determined as the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the carrying amount of the asset, and is recognised in the statement of comprehensive income.

#### **Provisions**

Provisions are made when the Foundation has a present legal or constructive obligation as a result of past events, when it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, and when a reliable estimate of the amount can be made.

Provisions are reviewed at the end of each reporting year and adjusted to reflect the current best estimate. Where the effect of time value of money is material, the amount of provision is the present value of the expenditure expected to be required to settle the obligation.

#### **Financial Instruments**

##### **(a) Initial Recognition and Measurement**

The Foundation recognises a financial asset or a financial liability in the statement of financial position when, and only when, the Foundation becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the instrument.

On initial recognition, all financial assets and financial liabilities are measured at fair value, which is generally the transaction price, plus transaction costs if the financial asset or financial liability is not measured at fair value through profit or loss. For instruments measured at fair value through profit or loss, transaction costs are expensed to profit or loss when incurred.

##### **(b) Derecognition of Financial Instruments**

For derecognition purposes, the Foundation first determines whether a financial asset or a financial liability should be derecognised in its entirety as a single item or derecognised part-by-part of a single item or of a group of similar items.

A financial asset, whether as a single item or as a part, is derecognised when, and only when, the contractual rights to receive the cash flows from the financial asset expire, or when the Foundation transfers the contractual rights to receive cash flows of the financial asset, including circumstances when the Foundation acts only as a collecting agent of the transferee, and retains no significant risks and rewards of ownership of the financial asset or no continuing involvement in the control of the financial asset transferred.

A financial liability is derecognised when, and only when, it is legally extinguished, which is either when the obligation specified in the contract is discharged or cancelled or expires. A substantial modification of the terms of an existing financial liability is accounted for as an extinguishment of the original financial liability and the recognition of a new financial liability. For this purpose, the Foundation considers a modification as substantial if the present value of the revised cash flows of the modified terms discounted at the original effective interest rate differs by 10% or more when compared with the carrying amount of the original liability.

(c) **Subsequent Measurement of Financial Assets**

After initial recognition measurement, the Foundation measures all financial assets at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

All financial assets are subject to review for impairment in accordance with impairment and uncollectibility of financial assets.

(d) **Subsequent Measurement of Financial Liabilities**

After initial recognition, the Foundation measures all financial liabilities at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

(e) **Recognition of Gains and Losses**

For financial assets and liabilities carried at amortised cost, a gain or loss is recognised in the statement of comprehensive income only when the financial asset or liability is derecognised or impaired, and through the amortisation process of the instrument.

(f) **Impairment and Uncollectibility of Financial Assets**

The Foundation applies the incurred loss model to recognise impairment losses of financial assets. At the end of each reporting period, the Foundation examines whether there is any objective evidence that a financial asset or a group of financial assets is impaired. Evidences of trigger loss events include:

- (i) significant difficulty of the issuer or obligor;
- (ii) a breach of contract, such as a default or delinquency in interest or principal payment;
- (iii) granting exceptional concession to a customer;
- (iv) it is probable that a customer will enter bankruptcy or other financial reorganisation;

- (v) the disappearance of an active market for that financial asset because of financial difficulties; or
- (vi) any observable market data indicating that there may be a measurable decrease in the estimated future cash flows from a group of financial assets.

For a non-current loan and receivable carried at amortised cost, the revised estimated cash flows are discounted at the original effective interest rate. Any impairment loss is recognised in the statement of comprehensive income and a corresponding amount is recorded in a loss allowance account. Any subsequent reversal of impairment loss of the financial asset is reversed in profit or loss with a corresponding adjustment to the allowance account, subject to the limit that the reversal should not result in the revised carrying amount of the financial asset exceeding the amount that would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognised previously.

For short-term trade and other receivables, where the effect of discounting is immaterial, impairment loss is tested for each individually significant receivable wherever there is any indication of impairment. Individually significant receivables for which no impairment loss is recognised are grouped together with all other receivables by classes based on credit risk characteristics and aged according to the past due periods. A collective allowance is estimated for a class group based on the experiences of loss ratio in each class, taking into consideration current market conditions.

#### **Operating Lease**

A lease is classified as an operating lease if it does not transfer substantially all the risks and rewards incidental to ownership.

The lease payments under an operating lease are recognised as an expense on the straight-line basis over the lease term unless another systematic basis is more representative of the time pattern of the user's benefit.

#### **Statement of Cash Flows**

The Foundation adopts the indirect method in the preparation of the statement of cash flows. Cash equivalents are short-term, highly liquid investments with maturities of three months or less from the date of acquisition and are readily convertible to cash with insignificant risk of changes in value.

#### **4. INCOME TAX EXPENSE**

No provision for estimated current tax payable has been made as the Foundation is exempted from taxation under the Paragraph 13, Schedule 6 of the Income Tax (Amendment) Act, 1967.

KUALA LUMPUR - A total of 30 percent of the completed Mykid child's identity cards at the National Registration Department (NRD) have not been claimed by parents or guardians, said Interior Minister Dato' Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail.
