“Biologic Complications in the Third Dentition: Diagnosis and Management”

The use of dental implants has revolutionized the treatment of partially and fully edentulous patients today. Implants have become a treatment approach for managing a broad range of situations due to their high level of predictability and their ability to be used for a wide variety of treatment options. Hence the goal of any treatment plan should be to prevent or minimize any complications. Prevention of biological implant complications relies on careful planning, a thorough examination to assess etiological factors and a regular maintenance recall schedule.
