#### **Clinical Experience**

More than 3 years of experience in urology at specialist level, One year as an international fellow and junior consultant. I am currently a serving as a Consultant urologist in Penang General Hospital since February 2020.

#### **Urology Surgery**

I am proficient in managing urology patients on the ward, intensive care, and outpatient clinic. This includes the handling of emergency resuscitation, monitoring critically ill patients, preparing patients for surgery and post-operative patient's care.

I am experienced in the insertion of central venous cannula from various routes, peripheral lines, arterial lines, chest drains, peritoneal dialysis catheter insertion or supra pubic bladder catheterization.

I am proficient in numerous outpatient urology procedures such as flexible cystoscopies both diagnostic and therapeutic having performed hundreds over the course of my career. I am proficient in performing diagnostic transrectal ultrasounds for biopsies and have recently adopted new technologies such as transperineally ultrasound guided biopsies and fusion biopsies as well in order to improve the outcomes for my patients so they may receive better care.

I have been well trained in endourology and have a keen interest in it as well. I am proficient in performing Transurethral surgeries for adults and also pediatric cases. I regularly perform Transurethral Bladder Resection of Tumors and also Transurethral Resection of the Prostate and am comfortable with new techniques such as Holmium Laser Enucleation of the prostate and Transuretal Enucleation of large prostates.

I am also competent in ureteroscopic surgeries for ureteric tumors and urolithiasis, with both rigid ureteroscopies and flexible ureteroscopies for retrograde intrarenal surgery. I am proficient in both supine and prone Percutaneous Nephrolithotomy for large renal and staghorn calculi.

As I have undergone a fellowship in clinical oncology, I have a keen interest in uro-oncology and am proficient in Open and laparoscopic nephrectomies. I am also proficient in performing radical cystectomies and prostatectomies. I have significant exposure to robotic surgery during my training in Adelaide. I am currently keen to look for opportunities to further train myself as a robotic surgeon.

I also have a keen interest in andrology and men's sexual health and have pioneered new technologies in Penang GH with a recently concluded study with shock wave treatment for erectile dysfunction, another new technology that I gained experience while I was in Australia.

I also am competent with Urodynamics and female urology dysfunction, with intravesical Botox therapy and other procedures. I have a keen interest in Pediatrics urology and have started the first ever combined Pediatric Urology Clinic in the

northern region as well as performing complex reconstructive surgeries for pediatric cases.

I am actively involved in offering my consultation on all referral cases reviewed either as elective or as emergency basis. This includes cases seen in clinic, in ward or ICU. Penang GH is a northern rereferral center covering Penang, Kedah and Perak. And I am the on-call consultant for two weeks in a month for our urology center.

I am regularly guiding my junior trainees in mortality meeting, reviewing articles in journal club and cases discussion. I am leading them in clinical trials and also supervising their progress in training.

I am also keen in learning new technologies and adapting and improving current practices in surgery to continue improving the outcomes for my patients.

#### **General Surgery**

Prior to my training in urology, I have been gazzetted as a general surgeon by Malaysia Ministry of Health.

I have 7 years of diversified experiences in general surgery. This covers a range of sub-specialty such as an upper gastrointestinal surgery, hepatobiliary, colorectal, pediatrics, breast and endocrine, urology, plastic reconstructive and neurosurgery I am trained to manage most of the cases either being an outpatient basis or on ward. I have also conducted elective surgery for cases within these disciplines, namely thyroid resection, breast surgery and upper GI surgery. Besides that, procedures like open or laparoscopic cholecystectomy, bowel resection or anastomosis, hernia repair and intraperitoneal tumor surgery are also included.

During my posting with those units, I have also carried out endoscopic procedures for diagnostic and therapeutic purposes. This covers upper and lower gastrointestinal scopes.

I am also competent in performing emergency laparotomy, visceral or bowel resection, splenectomy, liver packing, perforated gastric ulcer surgery, bowel repair or resection and handling gastrointestinal bleeding.
