Innovation within the chilled meat categories has increased over the years, and Asia has the highest growth potential in this category, globally.

Asia was the second most active region, globally, in terms of chilled and frozen processed meat categories. The major companies are promoting the health benefits of animal proteins in countries, like India to increase the growth of the market. The rising demand for organic livestock is an opportunity for vendors to increase their market share. Moreover, new product development accounts for 24% share of the total processed meat product innovations, led by China, Thailand, South Korea, Vietnam, and Philippines.

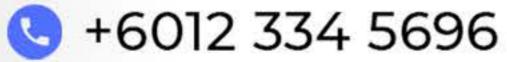

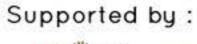

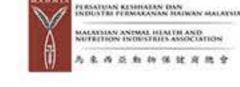
