## **Background information:**

"All research, to be generally useful, must ultimately be presented as a written document". Ideally publishing a research papers is important to share research findings and new discoveries, and to increase knowledge and understanding but it is also important practically to get funding, promotion, recognition.

The process of publication starts from proposing the hypothesis then searching literature for the same, through writing a good manuscript of your research, selecting appropriate potential journal to send it, following journal's guidelines, getting constructive criticisms from many potential reviewers and finally publishing it. Right from the beginners such as PG students to the experienced researcher the process of publication is cumbersome if proper guidance is not there for each and every step.

This course will help to decode the myths related to each and every step of your publication.

## Important topics/concepts covered:

- Different types of writing material that can be published with special emphasis on journal papers, systemic review, conference paper
- How to use the tools that helps in writing the manuscript such as, plagiarism software, reference managers
- How to select journal, decoding myths with impact factor, Immediacy factor, ISSN
- How the decision process of journals work
- How to access your published article and make sure it has an impact.
