- Learning objectives Prosthodontics is an alluring specialty that combines art and scientific skills. Preparation of the tooth to receive partial veneer crown (PVC) is based on definitive principles to ensure efficiency and durability of restoration. Till date, only scant course target on this domain of prosthodontics. The objective of this course is to disseminate knowledge and scientific skills in tooth preparation of all designs of "Partial veneer crowns".
- Background information Partial veneer crowns are conservative indirect restorations with one or more surfaces left intact. It is an evident fact that tooth preparation is an irreversible iatrogenic interventional procedure. When adequate retention, stability, support and aesthetics is feasible without involving all the surfaces of the tooth, "partial veneer crowns" are the choice of treatment. Several designs of PVC exists and its selection depends on the particular clinical situation. Thus, it is fundamentally essential as a specialist to know the nuances of its preparation.
- Important topics/concepts covered Introduction to partial veneer crowns, highlighting its advantages, enumeration of various designs of PVC, armamentarium and step-by-step demonstration of maxillary posterior three-quarter crown, mandibular posterior three-quarter crown, maxillary posterior seven-eight crown, mandibular posterior reverse three-quarter crown, mandibular molar proximal halfcrown, anterior three-quarter crown and pin-modified crown, pros and cons with indications and contraindications of each crown will be taught.

The unique selling point of this course shall be streaming of live demonstration of each step in preparation of various designs of PVC.
