PRIVACY POLICY

International Institute of Wellness & Aesthetic Medicine (IIWAM), previously known as IIWAM is a subsidiary, wholly owned and operated by IWAM INTERNATIONAL PTY LTD (1151329A) a company incorporated under the laws of Malaysia. It is IIWAM's policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our website and links. The official website for IWAM is <https://www.iiwam.ac> with the suffix ac, meaning academia.

1. About the Policy

- 1.1. This Privacy Policy applies to <https://iiwam.ac> (hereinafter, "us", "we", or "<https://iiwam.ac>"). We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting personally identifiable information you may provide us through the Website. We have adopted this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") to explain what information may be collected on our website, how we use this information, and under what circumstances we may disclose the information to third parties. This Privacy Policy applies only to information we collect through the Website and does not apply to our collection of information from other sources. Please refer to our Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA) and / or the Consent Form on how IIWAM uses data collected from you.
- 1.2. This Privacy Policy, together with the Terms and conditions posted on our Website, set forth the general rules and policies governing your use of our Website. Depending on your activities when visiting our Website, you may be required to agree to additional terms and conditions.

2. Website Visitors

- 2.1. Like most website operators, IIWAM collects non-personally identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. IIWAM's purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how IIWAM's visitors use its website. From time to time, IIWAM may release non-personally identifying information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website.
- 2.2. IIWAM also collects potentially personally identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for logged in users and for users leaving comments on <https://iiwam.ac> blog posts. IIWAM only discloses logged in user and commenter IP addresses under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally identifying information as described below.

3. Gathering of Personally Identifying Information

- 3.1. Certain visitors to IIWAM's websites choose to interact with IIWAM in ways that require IIWAM to gather personally identifying information. The amount and type of information that IIWAM gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, in the online enquiry, we need to collect your contact details, gender, date of birth, occupation and more. In the registration form, we need more details such as your home and work addresses, your college information, financial details, and other sensitive issue. This information will be used to reply to your queries and to process your application only. It shall not be shared with any third party without your prior written approval.

4. Security

- 4.1. The security of your Personal Information is important to us but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

5. Advertisements

- 5.1. Ads appearing on our website may be delivered to users by advertising partners, who may set cookies. These cookies allow the ad server to recognize your computer each time they send you an online advertisement to compile information about you or others who use your computer. This information allows ad networks to, among other things, deliver targeted advertisements that they believe will be of most interest to you. This Privacy Policy covers the use of cookies by IIWAM and does not cover the use of cookies by any advertisers.

6. Links to External Sites

- 6.1. Our Service may contain links to external sites that are not operated by us. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that third party's site. We strongly advise you to review the Privacy Policy and terms and conditions of every site you visit.
- 6.2. We have no control over, and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies or practices of any third-party sites, products, or services.

7. Google AdWords for remarketing

- 7.1. The website <https://iiwam.ac> uses Google AdWords for remarketing and the remarketing services to advertise on third party websites (including Google) to previous visitors to our site. It could mean that we advertise to previous visitors who haven't completed a task on our site, for example using the contact form to make an enquiry. This could be in the form of an advertisement on the Google search results page, or a site in the Google Display Network. Third-party vendors,

including Google, use cookies to serve ads based on someone's past visits. Of course, any data collected will be used in accordance with our own privacy policy and Google's privacy policy.

- 7.2. You can set preferences for how Google advertises to you using the Google Ad Preferences page, and if you want to you can opt out of interest-based advertising entirely by cookie settings or permanently using a browser plugin.

8. Aggregated Statistics

- 8.1. IIWAM may collect statistics about the behavior of visitors to its website. IIWAM may display this information publicly or provide it to others. However, IIWAM does not disclose your personally identifying information.

9. Cookies

- 9.1. To enrich and perfect your online experience, IIWAM uses "Cookies", similar technologies and services provided by others to display personalized content, appropriate advertising, and store your preferences on your computer.
- 9.2. A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. IIWAM uses cookies to help IIWAM identify and track visitors, their usage of <https://iiwam.ac> and their website access preferences. IIWAM visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using IIWAM's websites, with the drawback that certain features of IIWAM's websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.
- 9.3. By continuing to navigate our website without changing your cookie settings, you hereby acknowledge and agree to IIWAM's use of cookies.

10. E-commerce

- 10.1. Those who engage in transactions with IIWAM – by purchasing IIWAM's services or products, are asked to provide additional information, including as necessary the personal and financial information required to process those transactions. In each case, IIWAM collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfil the purpose of the visitor's interaction with IIWAM. IIWAM does not disclose personally identifying information other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personally identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities.

11. Privacy Policy Changes

- 11.1. Although most changes are likely to be minor, IIWAM may change its Privacy Policy from time to time, and in IIWAM's sole discretion. IIWAM encourages visitors to frequently check this page for any changes to its Privacy Policy. Your continued use of this site after any change in this Privacy Policy will constitute your acceptance of such change.
